- Place:** Jackson High School, 500 Vaughn Street, Jackson, Ohio 45640
- Date:** Sunday, January 21, 2024
- Teams:** TBD – Varsity Girls and Middle School Girls - Simultaneously
- Entry Fee:** \$250 (\$30 per wrestler up to 8 wrestlers) Make check payable to: Jackson City Schools

- Format:** Multiple Pools (4 or 5 mats depending on entries).
- Seeding:** We will seed the top 8 in each weight class by criteria only using last year's state (top 8), district (top 6), sectional (top 4) and current record (10-match minimum 50% or higher) as the criteria. Varsity Criteria Only. Submit records and criteria for all wrestlers as any weight class over 16 starters will have the lowest criteria wrestler moved to an external pool. **Please submit records with all wrestlers. Should a weight class have more than 16 wrestlers, those put in pools outside the tournament will be selected based on criteria (extras removed first). A wrestler with no record will be given the lowest priority.**
