- 8:15pm (approx.) Weigh outs begin after 144 pound Quarterfinal Match.
- 9:30pm Estimated day 1 completion time. Weigh-ins end 30 minutes after final match of evening.

- 8:00am Weigh-ins for those wrestlers who did not make weight during weigh-outs the night before.
- 8:45am Facility Opens to the Public.
- 9:30am Skin/Hair & Nails Check for consolation wrestlers (in wrestling room where weigh-ins were conducted).
- 10:00am Wrestling starts. 2nd Round of consolation on 4 mats.
- 11:20am Skin/Hair & Nails Check for Semi-Finalist wrestlers (in wrestling room where weigh-ins were conducted).
- 11:35am Mat's OPEN for Semi-finalist warm-ups.
- 12noon Championship Semi-Final's on 2 mats, Consolation Quarterfinals on 2 mats.
- 2:00pm Consolation Semifinals on 3 mats.
- 3:30pm Mat's OPEN for Place winner's warm-ups.
- 4:00pm Finals Begin places 1st 6th on 3 mats.
- 6:15pm Estimated event completion time

Arriving at the Facility

There is a challenge we face when you arrive at the facility. School dismissal is going to coincide with team arrival. Please be very careful in the parking lot. Please try to arrive after 2:20pm to avoid traffic and you must enter through the participant entry gate outlined on the map. This is why we pushed weigh-ins back to 3:15pm and therefore a wrestling start time of 5:15pm.

Weigh-ins

Weigh-ins will be held at 3:15pm on Friday, March 1 with weigh outs for day 2 to be held on Friday after the 144 pound Championship quarterfinals have started. Additionally, a wrestler must have completed their wrestling for the day prior to weighing out. Skin, hair and nail checks will begin at 3:10pm. We will weigh-in by weight class in accordance with OHSAA rules. Please note that we will do a skin check on day 2 but have it broken down into 2 sessions. 9:30am Skin Check for consolation wrestlers before they wrestle at 10am. Then another window for the Semi-finalists at 11:20am before they wrestle at 12noon. Semi-finalist are allowed to do the skin check at the 9:30am time slot if they so choose.

Participant & Coaches Entry Passes

District Qualifying wrestlers and alternates are admitted at the pass gate. Additionally, coaches are admitted based on the number of qualifiers they have per the chart below:

- 1-2 Qualifiers One Head Coach and One Assistant Coach
- 3-4 Qualifiers One Head Coach and Two Assistant Coaches

5-9 Qualifiers - One Head Coach and Three Assistant Coaches 10-14 Qualifiers - One Head Coach and Four Assistant Coaches

*All extra personnel (i.e. statisticians, trainers, managers, etc.) are required to purchase a ticket at the regular admission price. School Administrators need to go through their home Athletic Directors hometown ticketing to get their complimentary online tickets. We cannot accept any school or league credentials for entry. Tickets can be purchased at: www.ohsaa/tickets.

Brackets/Results/Bout Board:

All live brackets and results will be on **Baum's Page** throughout the tournament. Also, a QR Code link to the Bout Board will be posted around the gymnasium for easy access from your mobile device.

Concessions & Hospitality

There will be a full concession stand on both Friday and Saturday during the tournament. There will not be a hospitality room for coaches so please plan accordingly. Team food areas must be kept in the cafeteria area. No food or drink is allowed in the gymnasium.

Coaches Attire & Professionalism

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of <u>jeans</u>, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are **not considered suitable** attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will **not be allowed** on the competition floor.
