Weigh Ins

- 3 scales will be used for weighing in contestants. Scales will be open to check weights from 2:15-2:45 on Friday and 7:30-7:45 on Saturday morning.
- All wrestlers shall be present and remain in designated area
- Weigh-ins will be done by weight class beginning with 106 lbs and will begin with skin checks.
- Wrestlers get two tries on the first scale, then one try on each additional scale.
- Weigh ins will be completed in the Norwalk High School Auxiliary Gym.

General Information

Team and Coach Info

- On Friday, March 2nd, school will still be in session until 2:30. Please do not arrive prior to 2:00. All wrestlers and coaches will be directed to stay in the auxiliary gym until school is dismissed at 2:30.

Buses/Transportation

- Drop off for wrestlers will be at the back of Norwalk High School. Bus and van parking will be located in the Performing Arts Center Parking lot located on the opposite side of the main entrance of Norwalk High School. A map of the school is included at the end of this packet.

Check-In

- On Friday, please use the back entrance to the high school and proceed to the auxiliary gym for check in and weigh-ins. Only the head coach may pick up your packet. Your packet will contain the following: Brackets, team information, wristbands (also good for hospitality room). All extra personal will have to pay the regular admission prices.
- ADDITIONAL COACHING WRISTBANDS WILL \$15

Team Wristband will be given as follows:

1-2 qualifiers	2 wristbands
3-4 qualifiers	3 wristbands
5-9 qualifiers	4 wristbands
10-14 qualifiers	5 wristbands

Wristbands cannot be removed or altered, as it is your admittance to the tournament on Saturday.

No one is allowed on the floor or able to coach without a wristband on.

Media & Photographers

- All requests for media credentials at sectional/district tournaments shall be directed to the tournament manager in advance. Proper credentials must be presented for admission at pass gate

Tournament Procedural Information

- 4 mats will be used for sessions 1 & 2.
- 3 mats will be used for finals

- Auxiliary gym will be used as warm-up/staging area for wrestlers. We ask that all bags for wrestlers competing be left in the auxiliary gym. We will have two adults supervising the gym at all times and helping with staging wrestlers.
- Only wrestlers in uniform and coaches with wristbands will be allowed on the floor.
- Only two coaches/team personal will be permitted mat side-this will strictly be enforced
- A bout board will be used in the main and auxiliary gyms to designate mat placement.

Concessions

A concession stand will be run by the Norwalk Athletic Booster and they will provide a wide variety of food for sale beginning at 3:00 on Friday and all day Saturday. Coolers for team meals will only be allowed in our cafeteria area. There will be no crockpots allowed!

Hospitality Room

This area is for coaches, officials, and tournament staff only. This area will have someone in there at all times to make sure that only those with wristbands are able to enter. Subway will be providing dinner on Friday and lunch on Saturday.

Professionalism of Coaches

It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits, and warm-up suits (top or bottom, head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District, or State Wrestling

Tournaments and, therefore are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement. Scoring/Awards

- 6 places will be scored-the top 4 place winners in each weight qualify for the OHSAA State Tournament
- Individual medals will be presented to the top 6 place winners in each weight
- Team trophies will be presented to the District Champion and Runner-Up team
- Medals will be awarded to the coach of the Champion and Runner-up Team

Dress Code for Awards

All wrestlers receiving a district award will wear his/her team's wrestling warm-ups at the time of the presentation.
