II. Awards:

Awards are set by NWADB and OHSAA. The top 4 wrestlers will advance to the Districts. Districts will be at Norwalk High School on March 1st and 2nd.

III. If you have not already done so, please complete the following:

\_\_\_\_\_ A typewritten TEAM Pass List which includes: 14 wrestlers, coaches and administrators and bus driver. A school with 8 or more wrestlers will be issued 11 passes and a school with 7 or fewer wrestlers will be issued 8 passes.

\_\_\_\_\_ Your emergency contact information.

IV. Teams are reminded to bring locks for their lockers.

V. Teams entered: Bellevue, Bowling Green, Clyde, Columbian, Rogers, Toledo Central Catholic, Woodward, Kenton, Upper Sandusky, Maumee, Port Clinton (11teams)

VI. League Passes will not be accepted. A school with 8 or more wrestlers will be issued 11 passes. Schools with 7 or fewer wrestlers will be issued 8 passes. Only those passes issued by the Northwest District Athletic Board will be accepted. A.D.'s, and Principals will sign in at the gate. Please send in the pass list ahead of time.

VII. Dress code for the awards and coaches. Wrestlers who are receiving an award will wear his/her team's wrestling warm-ups at the time of the awards presentation. Coaches are not permitted to wear jeans, t-shirts, sweat pants and warm-up suits (top or bottom) to coach in at any time. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority.

VIII. Seeding Information/Tournament Director:

If you are the AD in this email, please forward this email to your coach and have them send me their information - Name, Email, Cell #, and School.

A seed meeting will be held after the wrestlers have been seeded by criteria. It will be held on Saturday, February 23, 2019 after weigh ins. The meeting will be at Clyde High School. A coach or school representative must be present to challenge any seed placement. All wrestlers will be seeded by the criteria listed below.

All Entries must done using Baum's Page (see attached sheet for that information.) Please submit a tentative roster NOW - do not wait until February 21st to do this. There is a \$150 penalty for rosters entered after 7:00 pm on 2/21.

Seeding will be done by criteria. If any challenges arise, those will be taken care of during Saturday's coaches meeting.

**Seeding Criteria:**

A. Returning state placer (1-3) at any weight class o Returning state placer (4-8) at any weight class. A "New" (freshmen or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 25 wins and has defeated a wrestler listed above him on the list and has a higher winning percentage will be seeded above the returning state place winner at any weight class. The coach must e-mail the credentials to the manager

B. Returning district placer (1-6) at any weight class. A "New" (freshmen or upper classman that was not a contender last year) wrestler that has more than 20 wins and has a higher winning percentage than the returning district place winner will be seeded above the returning district place winner at any weight class.

C. Tiebreakers: The higher placer at each level earns the higher seed. If two or more wrestlers have identical place finishes, the wrestler returning at the same weight class earns the higher seed. Previous year's tournament place finish **MUST** have been at an OHSAA tournament. A return placer can be from Division I, II, or III. In cases where there is a tie on seed and the coaches vote, a coin will be used to break the tie for the seed.

D. Won/Loss Record (by percentage) from the current season (minimum of 12 matches). In the event of a tie in percentage, the wrestler with the most wins will receive the higher seed. If this does not break the tie, a coin-flip will determine the seed.

**Seed Meeting:**

A. A seed meeting will be held after the wrestlers have been seeded by criteria. It will be held on Saturday, February 23, 2019 after weigh ins.

B. A coach may challenge a seed only when: The wrestler being challenged is a maximum of one seeded position higher on the list. There was a head-to-head win during this season.

X. Your cooperation is requested in keeping food and beverages out of the gym. A concession will be available throughout the tournament. Please do not bring glass bottles. No large coolers, crock pots or roasters will be permitted. Please notify your parents ahead of time.
