Entry Deadline & Seed Nominations	Entries and seed nominations must be submitted via baumspage.com before 7:00 PM, Thursday, February 23, 2023. Note that each wrestler's overall record must be submitted. Wrestlers are locked into their weight class as of 7:00 PM Thursday. The preliminary seed nomination list will be posted on baumspage.com at 8:00 PM Thursday.
Bus Drop Off	Bus drivers should drop off and enter at the cafeteria entrance of the high school and park in the upper lot.
Team Check-in	7:15-7:45 AM
Alpha Master	Alpha Master Report reflecting minimum weight and date must be presented at team check-in. Wrestlers who need to make scratch weight should have their name circled on the Alpha Master Sheet.
Skin Checks Weigh-Ins	8:00 AM (by sectional and weight class) Two certified scales will be available. If any wrestler needs to make scratch weight, please report that at team check-in via the Alpha Master Sheet.
Seed Meeting	8:10 AM (sectional 1) & 8:40 AM (sectional 2) - Please review seeding procedure.
Start Time	10:00 AM
Admission	Tickets are \$8 for adults and \$6 for students. All tickets must be purchased online at https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets
Passes	No school or league issued passes will be accepted. 1 wrestler - 2 coach passes 2-4 wrestlers - 3 coach passes 5-9 wrestlers - 4 coach passes 10-14 wrestlers - 5 coach passes
Concessions	Concessions will be available.
Team Food	No coolers, no crockpots or other electrical food devices, etc. are permitted at the site.
Hospitality	A hospitality room will be available for coaches, officials and tournament workers.
Locker Rooms	Access to locker rooms will be limited and monitored.
Officials	Assigned by the OHSAA Southeast District Athletic Board.
Athletic Trainer	A certified athletic trainer will be available during the event.

*It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. *Personal grooming and appropriate dress is standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited.* Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.*
