2023 Centerville Division I Sectional Individual Wrestling Tournaments

Tuesday, February 23, 2023

Submit *Online Roster and Seed Nomination Form* needs to be submitted on Baumspage by 7:00 PM. (online entry window opens on January 23, 2022 at 8:00 AM)

Thursday, February 23, 2023 7:30 PM seed meeting, virtual (Zoom meeting notice to follow)

- A. We will seed the top six wrestlers in each weight class based on the OHSAA and SWDAB criteria. The major criteria are:
 - 1. State and District place from 2020/2021
 - 2. Current overall record (12-match minimum & .500 or better record)
 - 3. Coaches may submit a request to add a wrestler with a winning record but fewer than 12 matches to the seed nomination list by e-mailing supporting documentation to the tournament director and head scorekeeper at least 24 hours in advance of the seed meeting. Coaches will vote on the request for inclusion to the seed nomination list at the seed meeting.

B. Challenges will be permitted on the following grounds and resolved in accordance with the SWDAB Seed Meeting Guidelines:

- 1. Head to head competition
- 2. Common tournament placement at the same weight class
- C. Brackets will be drawn after weigh-ins on Saturday.

Saturday, February 25, 2023

7:00 AM: Teams may enter the main gym and proceed to their assigned team areas. Coaches will report to the head scorekeeper to sign in at the tournament computer and review listed records, making corrections as

needed. Please check all names, spelling and records on weigh-in sheet. Data will update automatically and transfer to the Division I District Wrestling Tournament for those wrestlers who qualify.

Note: The head scorekeeper will use **Track Wrestling** to run both sessions of the tournament.

7:15 AM Weigh-ins/Skin Checks: Weight classes will be called to report to the designated weigh-in area. Wrestlers will report to the scales wearing their singlets (straps on shoulders). Tournament officials and weigh-in officials will communicate this information upon arrival.

- A. All *OHSAA Skin Authorizations* are to be appropriately signed and dated and must be presented at check-in.
- B. Tournament officials will conduct the **weigh-in by weights**. Wrestlers may step on and off the first scale two times. Wrestlers who fail to make weight on the first scale, shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight.

8:00-8:50 AM Warm-Up Session: There will be four mats available for warm-ups.

8:50-9:00 AM: Mat cleaning

9:15 AM Wrestling Begins

Wrestlers will warm-up the Aux. gym on the mat provided for wrestlers to warm. Each wrestler will enter the Main gym through a passage that connects the Aux. gym to the Main gym. Wrestlers will report to the entrance to the main gym and proceed to assigned mat.

Schedule:

First Round (2,3,3.5,4) Quarterfinals (5,6,6.5,7) First Consolation (1,2,2.5,3) Depending on the number of entries in each weight class, some wrestlers in first round consolation matches may have a bye Second Round Second Consolation (1,2,2.5,3) Semifinals (11,12,12.5,13) and Third Consolation (4,5,5.5,6) *Please note: Semifinals and Third Consolation will be wrestled simultaneously.* Consolation Semifinals

Finals or placement Matches (approximately 4:00 pm): First (4,4.5,5,6) Third (2,3,3.5,4) and Fifth (2,3,3.5,4) will be wrestled simultaneously.

Note: The time for the finals (first, third and fifth placement matches) is an approximation. We will begin the finals within 30 to 45 minutes after the conclusion of the consolation semifinal bouts.

All rounds of the tournament will be wrestled consecutively. Proper rest will be given when required in accordance with NFHS Wrestling Rules (45-minute rule). The top six wrestlers will be recognized and the tournament bracket will be presented to the first-place finisher in each weight class.
