Personal grooming and appropriate dress is a standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA sectional, district or state wrestling tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.

In the case of bad weather for the sectional tournament we will contact each school through the Athletic Directors or Head Coaches and enact one of the following plans:

Plan A: If bad weather is imminent for Saturday morning, but we can wrestle on Saturday afternoon, we will wrestle the first session at the time the second session is scheduled and wrestle the second session on Saturday afternoon.

Plan B: If bad weather cancels Saturday, we should be able to complete our sectional on Sunday, February 25, following the same schedule as Saturday. (Weight - scratch +3)

Plan C: If wrestling is canceled both Saturday and Sunday then we will wrestle the morning session on Monday evening and afternoon session on Tuesday evening.
