The OHSAA and Assistant Commissioner Beau Rugg have decided to grant weigh-in relief to all schools wrestling this upcoming weekend including Friday January 31st. and Saturday February 1st.

Each weight class will be scratch weight plus four pounds. Therefore, if a team is participating in a two day conference tournament the weight classes will be scratch plus four pounds for both days.

This is the maximum allowed by NFHS rule. Granting the weigh-in relief is fair for all and safe for the athletes.
