Dear Coach,

Established in 1969 as one of the first Invitational Tournaments in the Tri-State area, the 50th annual Doan Ford-Barnesville Wrestling Invitational welcomes you to the prestigious tournament to be held on December 13-14, 2019.

Due to the distance many teams will be traveling, there will be no coaches seeding meeting. We will communicate through an email list and other electronic means. The seeding for the tournament will be completed by a committee based on seeding criteria via **Baumspage**. You must declare by Wednesday, December 11th at 7:00pm which weight class each contestant will be competing. Submit your entries on **Baumspage**. Wrestlers who do not make weight on Friday will be scratched and a bye will be inserted on the next bye line with adjustments made to balance the bracket. You will be permitted to replace a wrestler due to injury or illness up to 7:00pm Thursday, December 12th by calling (740) 359-7456.

The tournament will be held in the Barnesville High School Gymnasium. Currently 21 teams are entered in the tournament. The wrestling parents will be serving concessions Friday evening and Saturday until approximately 6:00pm. Several fast food restaurants are within walking distance. Coolers and electric appliances are not permitted in the gymnasium or cafeteria. Please pass this on to your wrestling parents.

Weigh-ins will begin at 2:30pm on Friday. Wrestlers must weigh-in each day prior to competition. Weigh-ins will be by team. A one pound allowance shall be granted for Saturday's weigh-in.

This is a true double elimination format. All wrestlers will be guaranteed at least two bouts. Trophies will be presented to the first and second place teams. A plaque will be presented to the most outstanding wrestler and the top 6 wrestlers in each weight class. An award will also be given to the wrestler with the most pins in the least amount of time in the Championship bracket. Doan Ford will sponsor the trophies and plaques.

Barnesville Doan Ford 2019 Seeding Criteria

(Must be submitted on Baumspage)

- Seeding will be conducted by a committee on Wednesday evening, December 11, 2019.
- · All entries, along with their relevant statistics, must be submitted online by 7:00 pm on Wednesday December 11th.
- · Seeding criteria, outlined below and developed as an objective tool to separate top wrestlers from meeting until later rounds, will be used for seeding.
- The seeding committee will have the final decision making authority. An emphasis will be placed on the top 8 seeds in each weight.
- · Where feasible, more than 8 wrestlers may be seeded. If needed, byes are placed on the brackets randomly and distributed evenly throughout the bracket.
- · Seeded wrestlers are then placed in their proper position and unseeded wrestlers are placed on brackets by random draw.
- Seeds will be published on www.baumspage.com following the seeding meeting.
- Brackets will be printed and distributed to coaches immediately following weigh-ins on December 13th. Printed brackets will be available for spectators.

Seeding Criteria

Placement of Top 1-8 Wrestlers on Bracket: We will place the top seeds in positions on the bracket where they will not meet up until the later rounds (if they are all able to advance to that point).

- Placement at National Caliber Events
- Placement at State tournaments
- Placement at Regional tournaments
- o Current record and last season record
- Internet- The panel will also use the internet to find how wrestlers have placed at other tournaments.
- Panel- This panel will be comprised of coaches and club directors.

Submit your intended roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!

- 1. Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at www.baumspage.com!
- a) Create your account early and enter your master alphabetic roster.
- 2. Please note the following changes on baumspage.com!
- a) All User Accounts from 2014-15 were retained, but the associations with the schools and teams were cleared. Underclassmen were advanced one grade level and retained.
- i) Please delete any athlete that is no longer on your roster.
- b) After login, the coach will be able to add multiple teams/sports/genders to the same account!
- 3. Go to www.baumspage.com and click Online Entries or Login to access your account.
- a) If you did not have an account last year, use Apply to create your account.
- b) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
- i) Please note: Passwords are case-sensitive!
- ii) If you don't know your password, click the **Forget your password?** link to have a temporary password e-mailed to you.
- Use Coaches | Select Teams to select your school from the drop-down list.
- a) Click **Get Available School Teams** | click **Select Sport** in the dropdown below | highlight your sport | then click **Make me the Coach**.
- If your school is not listed or somebody else has already claimed your team, use

- 5. Use Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes to enter athletes to your alphabetic roster.
- a) You may enter athletes one at a time by entering first name, last name, and grade, then **Add Athlete**.
- i) Type all names in upper and lower case. *Please check all entries carefully!
- b) Or you can import your complete roster by pasting them from an Excel file. Use one row per athlete: First Name, Last Name, and Grade. Highlight and paste into textbox, then click Import Athletes.
- 6. Use Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters to enter them in a tournament.
- a) Select your team | click Get Available Events | Select an event | click Get Roster.
- i) For each weight class, click Select a Wrestler and select athlete from drop-down list.
- ii) If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for seed!
- b) Click Submit Roster to save. Use Get Printable Roster to print a copy for your records.
- c) If a name or grade is not correct or an athlete is missing, use Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes to make the correction, and then submit your entries again.
- 7. Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!
- a) The window closes automatically precisely at the time and date listed.
- b) Submit Rosters early and return to make changes anytime before the window closes.
- c) Entries cannot be edited or submitted online after the window closes.
- 8. If there are any problems with the Online Form, click the Contact Us link and submit a Help Request.
