Re: 2017 CVC Wrestling Championships

Location of the event: Perry High School, One Success Blvd, Perry, OH 44081

Team Registration:

The deadline for on-line team registration is going to be Friday, February 3rd at 5:00 p.m. ***There is no seed meeting for this tournament.*** Only one wrestler per school should be entered into each weight class.

To register your team, go to <http://www.baumspage.com>, Click on the link in the center of the page titled "Online Entry System." On the left side of the screen, click on "Apply". Follow the instructions from that page. Once you have entered all of your information, click "submit your application". Then on the left side of the screen click on "Add/Modify Wrestlers" At the time you will want to submit all of wrestler's names, and additional information. Then click on "Submit Event Rosters" uses the drop down box to find Chagrin Valley Conference CVC Tournament. Then completed filling out the rest of your wrestlers data in the designated slots. Then click on "Save/Submit and Print Roster".

Keep in mind that wrestlers will not be permitted to change weight classes, or be replaced by another wrestler in the lineup, during the weigh-in/check-in process.

Preliminary seed information will be posted on Baums Page on Friday night once all entries are reviewed and sorted by the Tournament Manager.

Tournament Time Schedule:

This year's **conference tournament will be held as a ONE-DAY event.** The facility at Perry High School will be open from 7:00 a.m. for check in. Scales will be open for weight check at this time.

Skin checks and weigh-ins will start at 8:00 A.M. SHARP in the men's locker room by team in order of arrival. The head coach of each team should check in at the head table upon arrival. Weigh-ins will be scratch +2 (i.e., 106 = 108). If there is issue in arriving on time due to weather, traffic, etc. please contact either Josh Lowe or T.J. Rockwell by telephone and talk to one of us (i.e. don't just leave a message).

The pre-tournament coaches meeting will be at 9:15 a.m. in the hospitality room located off the northwest corner of the field house.

The preliminary rounds of wrestling will begin at 10:00 a.m. The following matches will be conducted in the field house on four mats:

- opening round
- quarterfinals and (if the weight class has more than 12 wrestlers) opening consolation round
- second consolation round
- semifinals and consolation quarterfinals
- consolation semifinals
- fifth place matches

After the completion of the fifth place match, there will be an approximate one-hour break (to be determined based on the end time of that round) prior to the start of the finals. Matches for first and third places will be conducted in the main gymnasium on two mats. There will be a "Parade of Champions" prior to the medal round.

Upon the completion of all weight classes, the top six wrestlers in each weight class will be recognized on the award podium. Additional awards for the team champion in each division, along with Outstanding Wrestler and all-league recognition, will be given out at the CVC athletic directors' meeting.

Either concurrent to the awards ceremony or immediately after, there will be a coaches' meeting in the hospitality room to determine league MVP's for each division (Chagrin & Valley).

Event Format: This is a double-elimination tournament placing the top six wrestlers. However, with this being a one-day event, there is the potential for wrestlers competing for third or fifth place to be competing in their sixth bout of the day. Should that situation arise, the wrestlers will be jointly awarded the higher place, unless there was a head-to-head meeting in the tournament or a differing outcome involving common opposition; in that case, the winning wrestler will be awarded the higher place by forfeit.

Teams Competing: Beachwood, Berkshire, Chagrin Falls, Cardinal, Cuyahoga Heights, Geneva, Hawken, Independence, Kirtland, Orange, Painesville Harvey, Perry, West Geauga, and Wickliffe (divisions as established by conference bylaws).

School Bus Parking: Busses may drop off in the bus loop near the high school and may park on the south end of the high school parking lot. There will be someone to meet the buses to direct them where to park.

Officials: Kelly Stillman will work as the head official for the tournament.

Admission: Admission will be \$8.00 for adults and \$6.00 for students for the first session, which includes all preliminary rounds, quarterfinals, semifinals, consolation semifinals, and fifth place matches. There will be a \$6.00 adult/\$4.00 student admission for the finals (first and third place matches).

CVC Passes will not be accepted. Senior Citizens (65 and older) will be admitted free of charge. Coaches (maximum of 4 per school) and participants listed on the team registration will be admitted free of charge. Each team may be granted up to two stat/managers for the event. Wrestlers not competing will be required to pay the admission fee.

Hospitality Room: Only Coaches, Officials and workers are permitted in the hospitality room. Each school will be given four wrist bands which will allow them access into the tournament and hospitality room. No wrestlers are permitted in the hospitality room.

Seeding Criteria for the CVC Wrestling Tournament

Established as per conference bylaws:

1. Returning CVC Tournament champions
2. Returning State place-winners (same weight class)
3. Returning State place-winners (different weight class)
4. Returning District place-winners (same weight class)
5. Returning District place-winners (different weight class)
6. Returning Sectional champions (same weight class)
7. Returning Sectional champions (different weight class)
8. Returning Sectional 2nd or 3rd place finishers (same weight class)
9. Returning Sectional 2nd or 3rd place finishers (different weight class)
10. Returning CVC 2nd, 3rd, or 4th place finishers (same weight class)
11. Returning CVC 2nd, 3rd, or 4th place finishers (different weight class)
12. Current Varsity Record (.500 or greater win percentage, more than 10 matches wrestled)
13. Should all criterion be tied at this point, coach vote/discussion

It is strongly encouraged that won-loss records be entered for all wrestlers, as it is a seeding criteria, and it also provides information for the tournament program
