## Online Instructions

Entry window opens: **8:00 AM, Sunday, December 9.**

Closes precisely: **5:00 PM, Wednesday, December 26.**

**Submit your intended roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!**

1. **Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)!**
    - a) Create your account early and enter your master alphabetic roster.
  2. **Please note the following changes on [baumspage.com](http://baumspage.com)!**
    - a) All User Accounts from 2011-2012 were retained, but the associations with the schools and teams were cleared.
    - b) After login, the coach will be able to add multiple teams/sports/genders to the same account!
  3. Go to **[www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)** and click **Online Entries** or **Login** to access your account.
    - a) If you did not have an account last year, use **Apply** to create your account.
    - b) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
      - i) **Please note: Passwords are case-sensitive!**
      - ii) If you don't know your password, click the **Forget your password?** link to have a temporary password e-mailed to you.
  4. Use • **Coaches** • | **Select Teams** to select your school from the drop-down list.
    - a) Click **Get Available School Teams** | click **Select Sport** in the dropdown below | highlight your sport | then click **Make me the Coach**.
    - b) If your school is not listed or somebody else has already claimed your team, use **My Tools** | **Online Help** and submit the appropriate **Help Request**.
  5. Use • **Coaches** • | **Wrestling** | **Modify Athletes** to enter athletes to your alphabetic roster.
    - a) You may enter athletes one at a time by entering first name, last name, and grade, then **Add Athlete**.
      - i) Type all names in upper and lower case. \*Please check all entries carefully!
    - b) Or you can import your complete roster by pasting them from an Excel file. Use one row per athlete: **First Name**, **Last Name**, and **Grade**. Highlight and paste into textbox, then click **Import Athletes**.
  6. Use • **Coaches** • | **Wrestling** | **Submit Rosters** to enter them in a tournament.
    - a) Select your team | click **Get Available Events** | Select an event | click **Get Roster**.
      - i) For each weight class, click on **None** and select the athlete from the drop-down list.
      - ii) If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for seed!
    - b) Click **Submit Roster** to save. Use **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
    - c) If a name or grade is not correct or an athlete is missing, use • **Coaches** • | **Wrestling** | **Modify Athletes** to make the correction, then submit your entries again.
    - d) Below the Varsity roster, please list potential JVs that may be able to fill open weights. **Please prioritize your JV wrestler list!**
    - e) Only JVs submitted online will be allowed to weigh-in and be allowed to fill open weights after weigh-ins are finished.
    - f) You may make changes to your line-up when you check-in Saturday morning!
  7. **Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!**
    - a) The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date** listed.
    - b) **Submit Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
    - c) Entries **cannot** be edited or submitted online **after the window closes**.
  8. Barring unforeseen difficulties, rosters, seed nominations and the entry grid will be posted by 9:00 PM on the 26th. JVs will be assigned to open weights after weigh-ins are finished!!
  9. **If there are any problems with the Online Form**, click the **Contact Us** link and submit a **Help Request**.
    - a) **Please allow up to 8 hours for a response! \*Most responses will be in less than 4 hours.**

# 2012 Thunderbird Holiday Tournament

- Place:** Lima Central Catholic High School
- Date:** Saturday, December 29, 2012
- Teams:** Arcadia, Bluffton, Carey, Coldwater, Cuyahoga Heights, Dayton Ponitz, Fostoria, Jefferson, Lehman Catholic, Northeastern, Ottawa-Glandorf, Paulding, Spencerville, Tinora, Wauseon, Wayne Trace and Lima Central Catholic (17)
- Format:** 16-team pool. If 13-16 varsity wrestlers – 4 4-man pools. If 11-12 varsity wrestlers – 3 4-man pools. If 9-10 varsity wrestlers – 2 5-man pools. If 7-8 varsity wrestlers – 2 4 man pools. Round Robin if 6 or less varsity wrestlers. We will fill the varsity pools within each format.
- Mats:** 3
- Seeding:** We will seed the top 4 in each weight class using last season's State(8 places), District(6 places), LCC Holiday(4 places), and Sectional(4 places), and current record(minimum of 7 matches) as the suggested criteria.
- Web site:** Use the **Online Entry Form** posted at **www.baumspage.com/** to submit rosters and seeds by 5:00 PM, Wednesday, December 26th.
- Times:**
- 7:00 AM: Check-in - confirm roster and check weight
  - 7:30 AM: Weigh-in by weight class – two scales. Weigh-ins end after the 285 lbs. class is done!  
**Wrestlers will get 2 tries on the first scale and 1 try on the other scale immediately with his weight class. You must notify Ron Williams before the 29th if you cannot arrive before 7:30 AM to request an extension!**
  - 7:45 AM: Seed\* meeting and drawing (\*Verify the seed criteria and confirm JV entries. There will be no challenges to the criteria!)
  - 9:30 AM: Wrestling - 1st Five Rounds of the Round Robin Pool
  - 5:30 PM: Finals - (subject to change – approximately 45 minutes after the round robin. We will clear the gym prior to the Finals.)
- Entry Fee:** Noted on contracts. (\$150)
- Admission/Tickets:** **\$12 all day. \$6 for finals only.**
- Scoring:** Places 1-8 (16-12-9-7-5-3-2-1).
- Awards:** 1st, 2nd, 3rd place team and coach plaques. 1st place wrestlers - medals and plaques. 2nd thru 6th place wrestlers – medals. Outstanding wrestler. Most pins; Fastest pin.
- Food/Hospitality Room:** Food will be provided for officials and coaches only during the day. Please have wrestlers eat in the cafeteria or lobby area. **NO COOLERS, FOOD or DRINKS** in the Gym.
- Lockers:** Lockers will be provided for the wrestlers. Please help out by monitoring your team in the locker room; athletes doing damage to lockers or other areas will be removed from the tournament with subsequent loss of points. LCC is **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items.

## **Additional comments and Notes:**

1. We are scoring the five round robin rounds using dual meet scoring with the range of points from 3 to 6 and a bye will receive 3 points.
2. Please check **www.baumspage.com/** for the seed list, open weights, and potential extra wrestlers that may be assigned to open weights.
  - **No JVs will be assigned until Saturday morning!**
  - JVs submitted online will weigh-in with the Varsity and be assigned during the seed meeting if there are openings in the weight class!

## **Rules and Scoring**

1. Time for matches will be 2-2-2 except Consolation matches (3rd-8th) will be 1-2-2.
  2. Scoring for the five rounds of the Round Robin will be dual meet scoring: 3, 4, 5, and 6.
    - Byes will be awarded 3 points.
  3. Pairings for final matches will be based on the criterion listed below.
  4. Places and points will be scored for 1st-8th.
    - Place points will be awarded to the finalists after all rounds of the round robin are completed.
    - Wrestlers competing for 1st will receive 12 place points. Likewise, those competing for 3rd will receive 7, contestants for 5th will receive 3 and those for 7th will receive 1 point.
    - After the final match, the additional place points will be included in accordance with tournament scoring.
      - First Place (4, 5, 5.5, 6)
      - Third Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)
      - Fifth Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)
      - Seventh Place (1, 2, 2.5, 3)

## **Tie Breaker Criterion**

Note: The following criterion is based on suggestions from coaches and adapted from the National Federation Wrestling Rules Suggested Tie Breaker for advancement of teams in dual meet tournaments or to eliminate a tie score in a dual meet competition.

Each wrestler will wrestle everyone in his pool. After the 5th round, the following criterion will be use to determine placement of wrestlers into the finals.

1. The wrestler who won the greater number of matches.
2. The wrestler who won the head-to-head match.
3. The wrestler who has been penalized the least number of team points for flagrant or unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for all matches.
5. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for all for falls, defaults, forfeits, or disqualifications.
6. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for technical falls.
7. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for major decisions.
8. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of points for decisions.
9. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of pins in the least time.
10. The wrestler who accumulated the quickest pin.
11. The wrestler who accumulated the greatest total point differential for decisions.
12. If none of the above resolves the tie, a flip of a coin will be used.
