When: Friday, December 8 & Saturday, December 9

<u>Location:</u> Lorain High School – 2600 Ashland Ave, Lorain 44052. Bus drop off is as follows:



<u>Times:</u> Wrestling starts at 5pm on Friday and 10am on Saturday. Finals will begin approximately 30 minutes after last round on Saturday. Weigh-Ins will start at 3:30pm, and we will be weighing out that evening. Teams should arrive no earlier than 3pm on Friday. Buses that arrive any earlier will not be able to get into the parking lot.

<u>Format</u>: Pool Tournament – Top 2 in each pool advance to the Second Day Championship Double Elimination Bracket and others advance to a Single Elimination Consolation Bracket.

Extras: We will allow extras up until a weight class is filled.

<u>Locker Rooms:</u> We will have multiple teams sharing two locker rooms. Wrestlers should bring locks to secure all valuables. Lorain City Schools will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Trainer: A trainer will be on hand throughout the tournament.

Team Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$400.00 to be paid to "Lorain City Schools"

<u>Hospitality Room:</u> As most of you know, Lorain provides a very impressive spread! Please just keep in mind that this is only for coaches, officials and tournament personnel.

Food: A concession stand will be open all day in the cafeteria. There will be no large coolers permitted into the facility.

Seeding

- 1. Previous State Placer
- 2. Previous District Placer
- 3. Previous Sectional Placer
- 4. Overall varsity won/lost record fort the previous year (.500 or better), minimum of 16 matches
- 5. If a tie in winning % exists, then the higher seed goes to the wrestler with the most wins.

<u>Awards:</u> Top 4 in each bracket receive medals, and there will be an MVP for both the upper and lower weights.
