<u>WRESTLERS</u>, once the registration is closed you cannot move your wrestler up or down. We will notify you on Friday if any extra wrestlers get entered in the tournament. **Please** provide us with an e-mail and good contact number to be reached in case we need

clarification.

FORMAT: The Tom Ellis Classic is a round robin style tournament with the goal of getting wrestlers as many matches as possible. This format will include the following:

- 1. Weight classes will be wrestled in either a round robin format or a pool/bracket format.
- 2. Weight classes with an odd number of wrestlers will be evened out with a J.V. wrestler (Madison will have first choice to add a J.V. wrestler).
 - a. All JV wrestlers used will wrestle and score points for the "JV Team". Please bring contrasting uniforms in the event that your Varsity and JV wrestle each other. Team points can be lost and deducted from the JV total. However, the wrestlers are the responsibility of the head coach of their respective school. Any points deducted from the coach while coaching a JV wrestler will be deducted from that coach's varsity team.
- 3. We will run up to five rounds plus the finals. We will wrestle for the top six places but will stay within the five-match limit.
 - a. All matches in a Round Robin Pool will be three 2-minute periods until the finals. Third and Fifth place matches will be 1-2-2. If a wrestler is in a consolation bracket, these will also be 1-2-2 periods.
- 4. Team points will be determined by dual meet scoring criteria.
 - a. There will NOT be any advancement points.
 - b. Placement points will be based on 6 placements.

FINAL ROUNDS: Consolation final matches (3rd-6th) will be wrestled approximately 30 minutes after the final preliminary match is complete. Allowing all wrestlers to achieve the required 45-minute break.

The Final Round will begin Immediately after the consolation final round.

The Championship Matches will take place under spotlights.

All Awards will be awarded mat side after the match.

SPECTATORS: All spectators should enter the building through the front of the High School. There will

be room available in the cafeteria for team food and items. There will be no electrical

service. Please leave the area as you found it.

No smoking is allowed on the school grounds.

SPORTS MED: Our Team trainer will be at the tournament all day. The Madison EMS will be notified

and on call.
