Dear Coach/Athletic Director:

Thank you for your participation in Midpark High School's 11th annual Len Pariano Invitational Wrestling Tournament on January 15th 2011. We anticipate another well run tournament that highlights quality wrestlers from our programs. **The tournament will once again be a double elimination bracket tournament with a new format which will only allow those who make the semi-finals to wrestle for 1st-4th place and those in the consolation bracket will wrestle for 5th-6th place.** Awards will be given for the **top 6 placers**. Have your wrestlers bring locks to lock their lockers. Midpark High school is not responsible for lost items.

Tournament Notes

- We will be wrestling on four mats in Midpark High School's main gym. Weigh-ins will be conducted in the boys locker room by weight starting at 7:00 a.m. Skin check and referee check over of wrestlers will be performed during weigh-ins.
- Championship matches 2-2-2 and consolation matches are 1-2-2. Matches will be each assigned a number that will be displayed on a bout board. We will not be announcing wrestlers to a mat or using a bull pen.
- We will have an athletic trainer and several student trainers on hand to handle injuries and blood issues when they occur.
- We would like a coach from the winning wrestler's school to present the awards for each weight class.
