**Roster/Seeds:** The BaumsPage Mobile Application will be used to set up and manage our tournament. We will utilize on-line entry and seed nomination capabilities. You will find roster and seed nomination entry information enclosed.

**Times:** Weigh-ins will be at 8:00am. Coaches meeting will be 8:25am. Wrestling begins at 10:00am.

**Format:** Full bracket tournament with consolation rounds..

**Awards:** NWOAL procedures.

**Scoring:** 6 places (16-12-9-7-5-3)

**Food:** Coaches' hospitality room will be complimentary all day until the finals. Concessions will be available as well.

**Admission:** Adults \$6.00. Students \$4.00. There will be a split session before the finals. You will need to pay to re-enter. Those wishing to stay in building during the break may wait in our auxiliary hallway where finals tickets will be sold.

**Passes:** Northwest Ohio Athletic League passes will be accepted.

**Busses:** Please park busses in the south end of the main parking lot away from the school.

### Friday, February 16, 2018

7:00PM Coaches Meeting

- A. Check-in (wrestlers locked into their weights)
- B. Please submit the Alpha Master weigh-in sheet.
- C. Seeding, by weight, per adopted NWOAL procedure (attached)
- D. Seeding nominees will be listed on the form based on the following criteria from 2017:
  1. State Place (8 places)
  2. District Place (top 6)
  3. Sectional Place (top 6)
  4. NWOAL Place (top 6)
  5. Current Varsity Record - No minimum.
- E. Seeds will be determined in order from first to fourth by vote of coaches.
- F. Brackets will be drawn, but none will official until after Saturday check-in and weigh-ins.
- G. Scoring: 6 places (16-12-9-7-5-3)

### Saturday, February 17, 2018

7:30 Sign-in at computer

- A. Correct names on rosters and confirm seed nominations.

7:30 Scales open for weight check:

8:00 Weigh-ins: Begin at 106 lbs. and end after 285 lbs. class is done!

- A. All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be presented at check-in.
- B. All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area.
- C. The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 106 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of the 285 lbs. class. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on each available scale one time in an attempt to make weight
- D. **If you anticipate a problem arriving by 8:00 AM, you must make arrangements prior to Friday to request an extension.** When your team arrives, all wrestlers must report to the weigh-in area immediately! Lighter weights will weigh-in immediately and upper weights will weigh-in with their weight class.

8:25 Coaches Meeting:

10:00 National Anthem

First Round (2, 3, 3.5, 4) \*If more than 8 wrestlers in a weight class.

Quarterfinals (5, 6, 6.5, 7) and Consolation First Round (1, 2, 2.5, 3) \*If more than 8 wrestlers in a weight class.

Semifinals (11, 12, 12.5, 13) and Consolation Quarterfinals (4, 5, 5.5, 6)

\*Semifinals and Consolation Quarterfinals wrestled simultaneously.

Consolation Semifinals (5, 6, 6.5, 7)

TBA **Approximately 60 minutes after prelims.**

Finals: All placement matches contested at the same time.

First Place (4, 5, 5.5, 6)

Third Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)

Fifth Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)

Awards will be presented after 285 Finals; please ask athletes to wear school warm-ups!

Online Instructions

Entry window opens: **8:00 AM, Sunday, January 28.**

Closes precisely: **6:00 PM, Thursday, February 15<sup>th</sup>.**

**Submit your intended roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!**

1. **Entries must be submitted using the Online Entry Form at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)!**
  - a) Create your account early and enter your master alphabetic roster.
2. **Please note the following changes on [baumspage.com](http://baumspage.com)!**
  - a) All User Accounts from 2016-17 were retained, but the associations with the schools and teams were cleared.
  - b) **Athletes from last season were advanced one grade and retained.**
  - c) After login, the coach will be able to add multiple teams/sports/genders to the same account!
3. Go to **[www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com)** and click **Online Entries** or **Login** to access your account.
  - a) If you did not have an account last year, use **Apply** to create your account.
  - b) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
    - i) **Please note: Passwords are case-sensitive!**
    - ii) If you don't know your password, click the **Forget your password?** link to have a temporary password e-mailed to you.
4. Use • **Coaches • | Select Teams** to select your school from the drop-down list.
  - a) Click **Get Available School Teams** | click **Select Sport** in the dropdown below | highlight your sport | then click **Make me the Coach**.
  - b) If your school is not listed or somebody else has already claimed your team, use **My Tools | Online Help** and submit the appropriate **Help Request**.
5. Use • **Coaches • | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter athletes to your alphabetic roster.
  - a) You may enter athletes one at a time by entering first name, last name, and grade, then **Add Athlete**.
    - i) Type all names in upper and lower case. \*Please check all entries carefully!
  - b) Or you can import your complete roster by pasting them from an Excel file. Use one row per athlete: **First Name, Last Name, and Grade**. Highlight and paste into textbox, then click **Import Athletes**.
6. Use • **Coaches • | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter them in a tournament.
  - a) Select your team | click **Get Available Events** | Select an event | click **Get Roster**.
    - i) For each weight class, click on **None** and select the athlete from the drop-down list.
    - ii) If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for seed!
  - b) Click **Submit Roster** to save. Use **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
  - c) If a name or grade is not correct or an athlete is missing, use • **Coaches • | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to make the correction, then submit your entries again.
  - d) You may make changes to your line-up when you check-in Friday evening!
7. **Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the "Entry Window" is open!**
  - a) The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date** listed.
  - b) **Submit Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
  - c) Entries **cannot** be edited or submitted online **after the window closes**.
8. **If there are any problems with the Online Form**, click the **Contact Us** link and submit a **Help Request**.
  - a) **Please allow up to 8 hours for a response! \*Most responses will be in less than 4 hours.**

## NWOAL Policy - Wrestling

**D. Wrestling champion** shall be the school with the greater number of points, with dual meets counting as one point per league win (or ½ point for each school if tied), and the league tournament standing counting one point and awarded in reverse order of finish. Schools tying for a position will share the points assigned these positions. The annual league tournament for wrestling will be facilitated by a bracket format with double elimination for the years 2005-2009. (Aug 2003)

### Seed Meeting

\*Draw the byes on the bracket first.

\*Seed the number one wrestler and allow the coach to place that wrestler anywhere he wishes on the bracket. This way the coach can avoid the bye and pick up more team points with a first round match. However, the coach can draw into a first round bye if he wants. Gaining the first seed will reward the wrestler with the opportunity to wrestle the first round.

\*Seed the number two wrestler and allow his coach to place him anywhere he wants on the bracket. \*\*The only rule with this type of seeding meeting is the second seed must go in the opposite half of the bracket from the number one seed.

\*Seed the number three wrestler. The third seeded wrestler must separate as far as possible from the number one and two seed, which means he must be in the opposite quarter bracket. However, the third seed can be placed in the same half bracket as the number one seed if the coach wishes to place him there.

\*Seed the fourth best wrestler. The fourth seed must separate opposite the quarter bracket from the other seeds.

\*The advantage to all the top four seeds is that they have the opportunity to be placed away from the byes.

\*In alphabetical order Archbold, Bryan, Delta, Evergreen, Liberty Center, Montpelier, Patrick Henry, Swanton, Wauseon pull a numbered pill out of the pill container as to what unseeded wrestler gets to be placed on the bracket by his coach. For example: Archbold, #1 seed is already on the bracket on line 4, Bryan #2 seed is already on the bracket on line number 5, Delta is #3 seed on line one and Evergreen is the #4 seed on line eight. In alphabetical order starting with the starting weight class, Liberty Center would be the third team to place their unseeded wrestler on the bracket.

\*At the next weight class Bryan would be next on the list to have a pill drawn for their team first if they do not have a seeded wrestler at next weight class because they had a seeded wrestler at lowest weight class. (May 2012)

### Weigh-Ins:

A. Weigh-ins will be supervised by two adults per scale.

\*Final determination of any issues to be determined by head official.

\*Weight will be written on the wrestler/athletes arm or hand and recorded to one decimal place (ex. 101.3)

B. Record and read weights (verbalize) as they are reported.

C. Coaches assist with supervision of weigh-in room.

D. Coaches required to advise managers of special apparatus, weights.
