TIMES:

7:15am Doors to the school open for teams and coaches only. Teams should enter the school through door 22. This is located between the gym and our Paradigm building. Scales available for weight check from 7:30am - 8am. Teams should check in at the head table in the main gym on arrival.

8am - Weigh-ins in the auxiliary gym. All wrestlers must be present during the weigh-ins in the auxiliary gym. Girls will be called by weight class, have skin and grooming check then step on the scales.

8:30am Doors open for spectators. Main spectator entry is through door 14.

9am - Coaches meeting in Paradigm center

10 am wrestling begins

Day schedule: all times approximate.

10am - 12pm 1st and 2nd rounds

12pm 1pm 1st and 2nd round consolation matches

1pm semifinals and 3rd round consolation

3pm consolation semifinals 4pm Parade of champions

4:15pm Finals

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE:

4 mats will be run throughout the tournament until finals. Finals will run on 3 mats. We will present awards at the end of the tournament by weight class and then the team awards.

PAIRINGS: Posted on website www.baumspage.com

PACKET INFORMATION: Participant passes, coaches passes, and programs will be issued to coaches at the head table. Please check in when you arrive. Locker room assignments will be posted.

COACHES CREDENTIALS to be given at check in:

- 1-2 qualifiers one head coach and one assistant coach
- 3-4 qualifiers one head coach and two assistant coaches
- 5-9 qualifiers one head coach and three assistant coaches
- 10-14 qualifiers one head coach and four assistant coaches

Only coaches have access to the floor and hospitality areas. All extra personnel (stats, managers, trainers) are required to have a ticket for admission. School administrators should use the OHSAA provided complimentary tickets through hometown ticketing

TICKETS: Tickets can be purchased in advance at www.ohsaa.org/tickets. Tickets may also be purchased at the door with cash. Tickets will be \$8 for adults and \$5 for students. Everyone will need a ticket other than the OHSAA coaches and the wrestlers competing in the tournament. School administrators and other school representatives should use the comp tickets that are provided by the OHSAA. Athletic administrators know how to access those tickets.

PARKING: Mentor High School lots. There is no fee for parking. Park in the North lot adjacent to the gymnasium for weigh-ins. All fire lane regulations will be strictly enforced. BUSES SHOULD PARK AT THE FOOTBALL STADIUM or ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF MENTOR HIGH SCHOOL.

SPORTS MEDICINE: A physician and certified athletic trainers will be present at all times during the tournament. The training room is located in the north center hall of the gymnasium.

PARTICIPANTS: Rule book will be adhered to. If you have special equipment, please show it to the head official at the weigh-ins for its legality.
