Entry Deadline & Seed Nominations	Wrestlers are locked into their weight class as of 7:00 PM Wednesday 2/21. The preliminary seed nomination list is posted on baumspace.
Schedule of Events:	
7:45 am	Doors open to team personnel (coaches, wrestlers, stats)
7:45 - 8:45 am	Team Check in will be in the Hallway leading to the gym as you enter the school to the right.
9:00 am	Weigh Ins / Skin Checks by weight class - will be at scorer's table in the gym
9:15 am	Seed Meeting will be in hospitality room in visiting hallway (team/wrestler side of gym)
10:00 am	Doors open for admissions and passes - Tickets online or CASH ONLY at the door.
11:00 am	Wrestling begins.
Bus Drop Off	Bus drivers should drop off at the circle in front of the HS then park near the tennis courts or in back parking lot. There will be one entrance which will be the main entrance to Greeneview HS.
Alpha Master	Alpha Master Report reflecting minimum weight and eligibility date must be presented at team check-in or prior to event. Wrestlers who need to make scratch weight should have their name circled on the Alpha Master Sheet.
Weigh-Ins	Two certified scales will be available. Weigh ins will be at the scorer's table in the gym. If any wrestler needs to make scratch weight, please report that at team check-in via the Alpha Master Sheet.
Admission	Tickets are \$8 for adults and \$5 for students. Tickets can be purchased online at https://www.ohsaa.org/tickets or via CASH ONLY at the door.
Team Pass /Check in List	Pass list should be turned in before event day Sunday Feb 25.
Concessions	Concessions will be available throughout the day run by Greeneview Athletic Boosters.
Team Food	No coolers, no crockpots or other electrical food devices, etc. are permitted at the site.
Hospitality	Coaches will get a concession ticket for a hot food item. Hospitality room will have breakfast items, fruit, snacks, drinks Number of tickets based on number of coaches on pass list via the number of wrestlers entered.
Locker Rooms	Locker rooms will be shared. We have two locker rooms inside the gym. Do not leave valuables. Locker room assignments with school names will be posted on the locker room doors.

Athletic Trainer	A certified athletic trainer will be available during the event.
Physician	A physician will be on site during skin checks to evaluate any skin related issues.
Weather	Plan A for Sunday is a two hour or more delay; Plan B is to postpone to Monday with 3:30 PM weigh-in
Contingency	and a 5:30pm start time. Any decision will be communicated via email and posted on baumspage.
Professionalism of Coaches	It is the moral obligation of all Ohio Wrestling Coaches to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects credit upon their high school, their profession and themselves. *Personal grooming and appropriate dress is standard of professionalism. The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits (top or bottom), head wear and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Sectional, District or State Wrestling Tournaments and, therefore, are prohibited.* Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.
