ADMISSION FEE:	Admission for the Pre-Regional Tournament will be available Online or with Cash or Credit Card at the gate. The ticket website is OHSAA Tournament Tickets. Adults - \$8, Students - \$5
SPECTATOR PARKING:	There will be NO CHARGE for parking per CDAB policy. Parking will be available behind the school next to the Athletic Event Entrance.
CHECK-IN:	Will begin at 8:00am at the main entrance. Please do not arrive before 8:00am.
WEIGH-INS:	Sunday at 9:00am PLEASE BE ON TIME
START TIME:	Wrestling will begin at 11:00am.
TEAM ENTRANCE:	Drop off for wrestlers and coaches is behind the school at the gym entrance. Teams will check in there using the pass list. Please have your wrestlers in order by weight class as they enter the building. Anyone not on the pass list will need to purchase a ticket to enter or show a Central District Pass. Teams must enter as a group, including wrestlers, coaches, stats, managers, etc. Please park ALL Team Buses on the south side of the building in the area labeled Bus Parking on the map.
FOOD/CONCESSIONS:	There will be NO CROCK POTS or WARMERS ALLOWED. You may have food and/or a cooler. Please let your parents know that this will be enforced. Team Camp areas with food may be set up in the auditeria. Please make sure these areas are cleaned before you leave.
TRAINING STAFF:	Our Athletic Trainer will both be present for the Tournament.
PASSES:	Only passes issued by the District Athletic Board will be accepted.
LOCKER ROOMS:	Locker Rooms will be in the back hallway of the gym and will be labeled for identification
HOSPITALITY ROOM:	The Hospitality Room is for HIGH SCHOOL COACHES ONLY!! We will provide each school with credentials for their coaching staff. These credentials must be worn to enter the hospitality area. The Hospitality Room will be located in the band room.



- **COACHES MEETING:** The coaches meeting will be held in the band room (Hospitality Room) immediately following weigh-ins.
- **CHEERLEADERS:** Please notify Nick Chrsitopher by Thursday, February 22 if your school will have cheerleaders.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Bus drivers will need proper identification to be admitted free of charge.
- **PROFESSIONALISM:** The wearing of jeans, t-shirts, sweat suits and warm-up suits, headwear, and similar apparel are not considered suitable attire for coaches during the OHSAA Tournaments and are prohibited. Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed in the competition area.
