Rosters: Entries and seed nominations will be done online with www.baumspage.com. You will find roster and seed nomination entry information attached. See enclosed information.

Seeding: Boys will seed the top 4 in each weight class using last season's District (6 places), Sectional (4 places) and current winning record (minimum of 7 matches). Head-to-head challenges* will be allowed. Girls will seed the top 4 in each weight class using last season's State (6 places), and current winning record (minimum of 7 matches). Seeding is by criteria.

Times: Weigh-ins will be at 8:00am. Coaches meeting will be 8:30am. (*Verify the seed criteria, confirm entries) Wrestling at 9:30am.

Format: Individual pool. If 9 or 10 wrestlers, two 5-man pools. If 7 or 8 wrestlers, two 4-man pools - top 2 in each pool wrestling in championship SF and finals bracket for places 1-4, and 3rd and 4th in each pool wrestling in consolation SF and finals for places 5-8. Full round robin if 6 or less.

Mats: Four mats.

Scoring: 8 places; dual meet scoring. (16-12-9-7-5-3-2-1)

Awards: Top four placers in each weight class, Outstanding Wrestler, Most Pins in Least Amount of Time and trophies for the top 2 teams.

Food: Concession stand ALL day in the field house!

T-Shirts: Will be available.

Admission: Adults - \$6.00.

Students - \$4.00.

Each team will receive admission for three coaches and three support staff.

The tournament director is Ken Baumgartner. He will run the seed meeting and ensure that we stay on schedule.

Please use the **Online Roster and Seed Form** posted at www.baumspage.com to submit entries **before 5:00 PM Thursday, Jan. 14th**. Check data carefully! Everything transfers directly to the computer program "as is!" The Online Entry Process is different this year; you will need to create an account first. Please do so early and submit a preliminary roster. You will be able to login anytime before the deadline to make correction or changes. *See detailed instructions on next page. Barring unforeseen difficulties, rosters, an entry grid, and seed nominations will be posted by 9:00 PM! **No additional seed nominations accepted after January 14th!**

Times: 7:30 AM: Check-in - confirm roster and check weight
8:00 AM: Weigh-in by teams – two scales. Weigh-ins end after the 285 lbs. class is done!
Wrestlers will get 2 tries on the first scale and 1 try on the other scale immediately with his weight class. You must notify Ron Recknagel **before the 14th** if you cannot arrive before 8:00 AM **to request an extension!**
8:30 AM: Coaches meeting and drawing. **EXTRAS MAY BE ENTERED!!** *Verify the seed criteria, confirm entries.
10:00 AM: Wrestling - 1st four rounds of the round robin pools and Semi-finals
Finals: Approximately 45 minutes after the last consolation match.

Format: Individual pools of 9-10, 7-8 or full round robin if 6 or less.

Awards: Top 4 places; 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.

Top 2 teams; 1st and 2nd place. .

Outstanding wrestler and Most Pins in Least Amount of Time

Admission: Adults --- \$6.00.

Students - \$5.00.

Food: Concession stand available ALL day! **NO COOLERS, FOOD or DRINKS** in the Gym.

Lockers: Lockers will be provided for the wrestlers. Please help out by monitoring your team in the locker room; athletes doing damage to lockers or other areas will be removed from the tournament with subsequent loss of points. Rossford Schools are **NOT** responsible for lost or stolen items.

Please have wrestlers ready when called to the mat. Keep others in the stands or in the warm-up area. Only two coaches or a coach and wrestler are permitted in the 2 chairs at the edge of the mat.

Wrestling will start with the First Round as soon as the pools are distributed and will continue with Rounds 2, 3 and 4 without breaks.

There will be a short break (app. 45 min.) before the Finals.

Online Instructions

Entry window opens: **8:00 AM, Sunday, January 3.**

Closes precisely: **5:00 PM, Thursday, January 14.**

Submit your intended roster early! Return anytime before the deadline to make changes!

1. An Online Entry Form must be submitted **before 5:00 PM, Thursday, January 14, 2021!**
The entry window opens at 8:00 AM, Sunday, Jan. 3.
 - a) Names transfer directly to the computer program, so list your wrestler in their weight.
 - b) Data entry should take less than 5 minutes so if you are not a “computer user” find an assistant, student, parent, or friend who is!
2. **You will need an account to submit data using BaumsPage.** Go to www.baumspage.com and use **Online Entries** or **Login** to access your account
 - a) Click the **Help** link and print **Online Entry Instructions for Wrestling** if you need detailed instructions.
 - b) **If you did not have an account last year**, use **Apply here** to create your account.
 - i) Complete the requested information | Check the “**I’m not a robot.**” box | Submit Application
 - c) If you had an account last year, you can login using that e-mail address and password.
 - d) Use **Coaches | Select Teams** to select your **School** and **Sport**.
 - e) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Modify Athletes** to enter alphabetic roster, using proper case.
 - f) Use **Coaches | Wrestling | Submit Rosters** to enter tournament.
 - i) Select wrestlers in their weight and click **Submit Roster** to submit!
 - ii) For each weight class, click on **None** and select the athlete from the drop-down list.
 - iii) If appropriate, enter seeding information as requested. Leave blank if not up for seed!
 - iv) Click **Get Printable Roster** to print a copy for your records.
 - v) Please submit tentative roster early! **Submit changes online** until the window closes.
 - g) **Extras may be entered!!!**
 - h) You may make changes to your line-up when you check-in Saturday morning!
 3. **Event Rosters can only be submitted or corrected while the “Entry Window” is open!**
 - a) The window closes automatically **precisely at the time and date** listed.
 - b) **Submit Rosters** early and return to make changes **anytime before** the window closes.
 - c) Entries **cannot** be edited or submitted online **after the window closes**.
 4. Barring unforeseen difficulties, rosters, seed nominations and the entry grid will be posted by **9:00 PM** on the 9th.
 5. **If there are any problems with the Online Form**, click the **Contact Us** link and submit a **Help Request**.
 - a) **Please allow up to 8 hours for a response! *Most responses will be in less than 4 hours.**

Rules and Scoring

1. Time for matches will be 2-2-2. Consolation matches (3rd-8th) will be 1-2-2.
 2. Scoring for the three rounds of the Round Robin will be dual meet scoring: 3, 4, 5, and 6.
 - Byes will be awarded 3 points.
 3. Pairings for semi-final and final matches will be based on the criterion listed below.
 4. Places and points will be scored for 1st-8th.
 - 4th Place points will be awarded to the semifinalists after the 3 rounds of the round robin are completed.
 - All semifinalists will receive 7 place points.
 - Semifinal winners will receive 5 place points plus 2, 3, 3.5, 4 advancement points.
 - 8th Place points will be awarded to the pool runner-ups after the 3 rounds of the round robin are completed.
 - All runner-ups will receive 1 place point.
 - Consolation Semifinal winners will receive 2 place points plus 1, 2, 2.5, 3 advancement points.
 - After the final match, the additional place points will be included in accordance with tournament scoring.
 - First Place (4, 5, 5.5, 6)
 - Third Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)
 - Fifth Place (2, 3, 3.5, 4)
 - Seventh Place (1, 2, 2.5, 3)

Additional comments and Notes:

1. We are scoring the three round robin rounds using dual meet scoring with the range of points from 3 to 6 and a bye will receive 3 points.

Tie Breaker Criterion

Note: The following criterion is based on suggestions from coaches and adapted from the National Federation Wrestling Rules Suggested Tie Breaker for advancement of teams in dual meet tournaments or to eliminate a tie score in a dual meet competition.

Each wrestler will wrestle everyone in his pool. After the final round of the round robin, the following criterion will be used to determine placement of wrestlers into the finals.

1. The wrestler who won the greater number of matches.
2. The wrestler who won the head-to-head match.
3. The wrestler who has been penalized the least number of team points for flagrant or unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for all matches.
5. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for all for falls, defaults, forfeits, or disqualifications.
6. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for technical falls.
7. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of team points for major decisions.
8. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of points for decisions.
9. The wrestler who accumulated the greater number of pins in the least time.
10. The wrestler who accumulated the quickest pin.
11. The wrestler who accumulated the greatest total point differential for decisions.
12. If none of the above resolves the tie, a flip of a coin will be used.
