

Tri-Valley Conference Championships Saturday, February 11, 2023 – 10:00 AM Wellston High School

Both the high school and junior high Tri-Valley Conference Wrestling Championship Tournaments will be held on Saturday, February 11 at 10:00 a.m. at Wellston High School. Should any TVC team qualify for the state wrestling dual tournament, the TVC tournament will be held on Wednesday, February 8.

Entry into this year's championship tournament will again be via baumspage.com. The entry window will open at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, February 5 and will close at 6:00 PM, Friday, February 10. No changes to your roster will be permitted for any reason after the 6:00 PM Friday deadline.

All high school weight classes will be bracketed. Junior high weight classes will be either round robin or pools.

The TVC bylaws will govern the tournament. Seeding criteria for high school: state (top 8), district (top 6), sectional (top 6), current season winning record with at least 10 match minimum. Head-to-head challenges will be accepted up until the start of weigh-ins. Seeding for the junior high tournament is: OAC state (top 8); OAC district (top 6); current season winning record with at least 10 matches. Head-to-head challenges will be accepted up until the start of weigh-ins.

Preliminary seeds will be posted on baumspage shortly after the entry window closes on Friday evening. All seed eligible wrestlers will be seeded. Head-to-head challenges will be reviewed at the coaches meeting. Once seeds are determined, wrestlers will be placed on the bracket/pool in the corresponding seed position. All non-seed eligible wrestlers will be randomly and automatically placed on the bracket.

We will be using three mats. All wrestlers should report to the bullpen area when their number appears on the match/bout board. The winning wrestler of each match will be required to return the completed bout sheet to the head table immediately after the match concludes.

For the high school tournament, the top three individuals in each weight class will be recognized at the end of the tournament. Each weight class champion's coach will present the awards to the respective weight classes.

The team trophy will be awarded immediately following the presentation of the 285 pound weight class awards. The MVW award will be the final award of the day.

For the junior high tournament, the top two individuals in each weight class will be recognized at the end of the tournament. No team trophy will be awarded.

Admission is \$7.00 per person. Only TVC issued passes will be honored for free admission. School issued passes are not valid.

Programs will be available and sold at the door once the brackets/pools have been drawn. Updated brackets and results will be posted on baumspage and on site regularly throughout the day. Please be sure to review the results and report any errors immediately to the head table.

A brief coach's meetings will be held at 9:00 a.m. to review the seeds and before the start of the finals to review all results and discuss the MVW. We will only take breaks as necessary to adhere to the 45 minutes between matches rule.

A certified athletic trainer will be onsite all day. Please bring tape or other supplies that you or your wrestlers may require.

In case of inclement weather, a decision as to whether the tournament will be held will be made by 5:30 a.m. Saturday morning. We will contact you and/or your athletic director by 5:30 a.m. if there will be a delay, cancellation or rescheduling of the tournament. Any weather-related announcements will also be posted on <u>baumspage</u>.
