District Start-Line / Finish Line Instructions:

MASKS ARE TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY ATHLETES IN THE STARTLINE CORRAL.


Entry to the District Meet

Upon arrival at the district meet, coaches should check in at the finish line indicated by a red "Check-in" flag for race information and competition packets. Teams will have a number on their race packet, which corresponds to their start-line corral and start-line box #. The number given to each team will be the same for their corral and box. FOR INSTANCE, a team that is given #3 will report to starting corral #3 and starting box #3.

Race Start Instructions

Teams will leave their campsite 10 minutes prior to the start of their race for check-in. Teams will report to their Start-Line Corral for team "Check In" by the clerking official. The official will check to make sure that teams are race compliant. Each team is to stay in their designated corral until race time. Two minutes prior to race time, a horn will sound by the official. At this time, team members may remove their masks and approach their designated starting-box. Runners will stay in their box until the start of the race.

^{*}No run outs or warm-ups will be allowed inside the corral. Coaches plan accordingly*

Finish Line Instructions

The finish line corral will be open for athletes to leave immediately after crossing the finish line. No athletes / coaches or spectators will be allowed to hang out in the finish line area. Please ask your team / spectators to disperse immediately and go back to your team camp.

Training staff will be on hand for injured athletes and emergencies only. No water will be provided except in emergency situations.

No congregating at the finish line after your race is complete; leave immediately
