District Assignments: Full teams (5 or more runners) will be seeded first.

Schools without full teams (4 or fewer runners) will be assigned to the district races by the manager.

- The teams will be assigned to their race by rank.
- #1 will be assigned to Race 1, #2 & #3 to Race 2, #4 & #5 will be assigned to Race 1, #6 & #7 to Race 2, #8 & #9 to Race 1, etc. until all teams are assigned.
- Race 1 through Race 4 will qualify to Tiffin.

Substitutes: Substitutions may be made via my email address at any time (cg_brodwolf@cg.noacsc.org). On race day you will need to make substitutions on the form in your team packet. Turn them in at the finish line timing tent.

Practice: You may practice at the Columbus Grove Athletic Facility from 5:40PM to 8PM October 19-23. October 22nd the course will open at 3PM. I would recommend coming on Thursday as our course goes through the practice football field

Spikes: Spikes can be no longer than 1/4inch. Our course finishes on the track.

Entry fee: New this year the OHSAA is charging all teams a \$25 entry fee

Tickets: \$8 ADMISSION TICKETS WILL BE SOLD THRU YOUR SCHOOL'S ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT AND TICKETS WILL BE SCANNED AT THE COURSE. PLEASE ADVISE YOUR PARENTS AND FANS THAT THEY MUST RECEIVE THE PROPER CODES AND PAY AHEAD OF TIME AS WE WILL NOT BE HANDLING ANY MONEY.

Packets: Assigned numbers/chip, safety pins, goes on front of jersey
Uniform checklist
Starting box assignment
Sub/replacement form

Bus Parking: Busses should park in the designated location on the course map. Athletes will be able to unload there.

Tents: Team camps should be set up in designated area on course map. Tents will not be permitted this year

Weather: If we experience lightning or other dangerous weather issues we will follow the OHSAA guidelines for this.

Restrooms: Restrooms are available where marked on the course map. Don't wear spikes in the buildings.

Results: Results will be posted on baumspage.com after each race.

Awards: The NWDAB provides awards for the 1st and 2nd place teams. In order to follow social distancing guidelines there will be no presentation of awards. Team awards will simply be given to the coaches.

T-shirts: District T-shirts will be on sale near the visitor concession stand.

Concessions: Various concessions will be available on the Clymer Stadium (west) side of the football field.

COVID-19 COMPETITION GUIDELINES

Players

- **Teams are responsible for conducting symptom assessment prior to travel to the competition venue.**
- **Recommend the wearing of face covering at all times when not competing.**
- **Six-foot social distancing must be maintained between individuals when not competing.**
- **Restrict congregating before or after competition.**
- **Supply own water bottle, equipment, hand sanitizer and personal items which are not to be shared with anyone.**

Spectators

- **Spectators should conduct daily symptom assessments. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.**
- **Six-foot social distancing must be maintained between individuals. Restricted spectator areas will be designated and marked. There are HOME side, VISITOR side, and BASEBALL bleachers available for parents to watch the races.**
- **No congregating before or after competition is permitted.**
- **Wearing of a face covering at all times is mandatory.**

- **Spectators should be limited to family members only.**

Starting Line

- **No pre-race instruction/meeting will be conducted by officials.**
- **Runners to arrive at the starting line no earlier than 5 minutes before the start.**
- **No spectators within 50 feet of the starting line area. Area will be marked as restricted.**
- **No items to be left or stored in the starting line area.**

Competition Considerations: Finish Line

- **No spectators anywhere near the start or finish line area or along the course.**
- **Athletes maintain 6 feet social distance in the finish area at all times.**
- **Athletes return immediately to their team camp area after finishing the race.**

Results and Awards

- **All results to be posted online. No results will be posted at the venue.**
- **No awards ceremony. All awards are to be received by the coaches prior to leaving the venue.**

Team Camps

- **Team camps should be at least 20' apart from each other. NO TENTS ALLOWED!!!**

- **Team camp area will be for athletes and coaches only, no spectators.**
