Schools without full teams (4 or fewer runners) will be assigned to the district races by the manager.

- All full teams will be seeded in their races. Teams will be assigned by their rank.
- #1 will be assigned to Race 1, #2 & #3 to Race 2, #4 & #5 will be assigned to Race 1, #6 to Race 2, #7 & #8 to Race 1, #9 & #10 to Race 2, #11 & #12 to Race 1, #13 & #14 to Race 2, #15 & #16 to Race 1, #17 & #18 to Race 2, #19 & #20 & #21 to Race 1 and #22 to Race 2, until all teams are assigned.

- In Race 1, 4 teams and those individuals not on a qualifying team who finish in the top 16 positions will advance to the Regional Tournament in Tiffin. In Race 2, 3 teams and those individuals not on a qualifying team who finish in the top 12 positions will advance to the Regional Tournament in Tiffin.

- Entry fee:** New this year the OHSAA is charging all teams a \$25 entry fee. Paid to the OHSAA. Do not turn in at the meet.

- Bus Parking:** Busses should park in the designated location on the site map.

- Restrooms:** Restrooms are available where marked on the site map. Don't wear spikes in the buildings.
- Results:** Results will be posted on baumspage.com after each race.
- Awards:** The NWDAB provides awards for the 1st and 2nd place teams. In order to follow social distancing guidelines there will be no presentation of awards. Team awards will simply be given to the coaches.
- T-shirts:** District T-shirts will be on sale near the visitor concession stand.
- Concessions:** Various concessions will be available on the Clymer Stadium (west) side of the football field.
