INFORMATION FOR TIFFIN REGIONALS 2018

OHSAA: There will be a \$7.00 admission fee per person.

NEW Only School transportation will permitted to enter the park. Upon arrival, all busses will travel around loop until reaching drop off area. All individuals except driver will disembark (but not unload team gear). Bus will proceed ahead using right lane of two lane stretch of the loop. The buses will stay in this lane until the athletics/coaches have been through the wristband/ticket process and are able to come and unload them, after which the bus can proceed to bus parking in lower level. The RIGHT lane will be for parking and unloading buses. LEFT lane will be for bus traffic.

Coaches, pick up envelope with wristbands. COACHES are responsible for putting wristbands on athletics/coaching staff. You CAN NOT enter without either a wristband/ticket.

Non-qualified riders will stand in ticket line at drop off tent and buy tickets before entering the event. There will be a premade receipt they can get to give to the coaches to be reimbursed. Tickets will be \$7.00 each. Coaches bringing individuals must have identification to get in with the runner/athletic, otherwise they will be charged.

Coaches after all this can go up to the big gray barn and pick up packets.

Team Qualifiers: 10 total tickets (7 team members, 1 head coach, 1 asst. coach, 1 alternate competitor or manager.

Individuals Qualifiers: Each qualifying competitor, 1 coach

Camp areas around the oval, same as before stay off course and residential yards.

All cars coming Coe St. can park on street or in church parking lot left of entrance. Cars coming to Summit St. will also park on street or in parking lot across from the National and walk to park. Everyone must purchase a ticket for \$7.00 to enter. There is handicap parking coming in the Coe St. entrance.
