- Site:** Amanns Reservoir on SR 309 and 61 approximately ½ mile south of Galion, Ohio. A Canon and Flagpole mark the spot.
- Entries:** A school may enter a maximum of one team (7 runners) only in a race. The Individual entries (4 or less) may be entered if a school does not have a minimum required for a team (5).
- Entry Deadline:** Entries must be filed online at www.baumspage.com no later than **5:00 P.M., Friday, October 15, 2021.**
Late Entries: OHSAA permission required with a **\$50 Late Penalty per team** [*Boys team – Girls team*] This is an OHSAA directive.
- Substitutes:** Substitutions may be made via my email address at any time (lucasari02@gmail.com). On race day you will need to make substitutions on the form in your team packet. Turn them in at the registration shelter house.
- Time:** The first race will go off promptly **at 10:00 AM** It is recommended that you arrive **at least one hour before** your scheduled race.
- Races:** A combined team and individual race will be run in each division.
- Weather:** If we experience lightning or other dangerous weather issues we will follow the OHSAA guidelines for this.
- Restrooms:** Restrooms are available.
- Results:** Live results will be posted to www.results.timingfirst.com. Results will also be available at the registration shelter house
- Awards:** The NWDAB provides awards for the 1st and 2nd place teams. We will present them 10 minutes after the results have been posted and become official. Try to have your team near the finish line to receive their award.
- T-shirts:** District T-shirts will be on sale near the result posting area.
- Concessions:** Various concessions will be available. Provided by Galion XC Parents.
- Course Inspection:** The course at Amanns Reservoir is always open for inspection.

Registration/Team Check In

All buses should enter the main park entrance off of ST. Rt. 61/309. Coaches registration and welcome station will be at the top of the hill located in the shelter house/barn on the left side of the road that circles the course. There will be a bus pull off area. We ask that coaches exit the bus and come inside to receive team packets and additional info. Do not unload your athletes, tents, equipment, etc. Only coaches will need to step off the bus.

THIS IS NOT A TEAM UNLOADING AREA.

Coaches may have their bus wait for them or the bus may proceed to the unloading area at the east end of the course. There will be another pull off area for bus loading and unloading. Again please do not unload your athletes in the registration area. Buses will proceed through the park. Coaches please remember to get your bus drivers phone number so you can contact them when you're ready for pick-up.

Bus Parking: Busses will exit the park and turn right (east) on county line road, turn right again (south) on ST.RT. 61/309 and proceed to the second drive on the right (Amicks Resv) and park in the designated location. Volunteer parking staff will be there to assist you. Bus drivers please have your coaches phone number so you can contact them when you are coming back through for pickup. Buses should travel the same route for pick-up as they did for drop-off.
