We have major changes to the course this year.

The Dover Public Swimming Pool will now be the center of the meet. This is right above the pond area. Parking will be increased as spectators can now use all the Dover Middle School Parking and all the Lower Dover City Parks Area to park. Just walk across the bridge to the pond area and follow the sidewalk to get to the swimming pool area. All busses and school vans will be parked in the Pool parking lot (no spectator parking in the Pool lot). We cross no roads with the new course. Maps and this letter is being sent to baumspage for posting on the website.

Directions: Take Interstate 77 to Exit 85 (Schneiders Crossing Road.) Turn east (left from the north and right from the south) to Wooster Ave. (If you go more than ½ mile without seeing stores you may have gone the wrong way on Schneiders Crossing Road). Turn right onto Wooster Ave. (For School bus/van parking) You will go past the front of the main entrance to Dover City Parks and East of Chicago. Take 20th Street left. This T's into Pool Road and Tremont turn left onto Pool Road. This takes you past the pond to the Pool and Pool Parking. Tents can be put up around the Pool yard. Packets can be picked up in the building and a concession stand will be open. T-shirts and the biddie sign up will be in the pavilion in front of the Pool.

T-shirts will be \$12. Results will be posted outside the building and on www.baumspage.com
