- Busses:** Bus parking will be in the back of the park. Someone will be there to direct the drivers.
- Packets:** Team packets will be handed out to each school bus as you enter the park. Numbers/chips will be included.
- Chips:** The number/chips are disposable and don't need to be returned..

- Teams:** **High School Gray division:** Sandusky, Bellevue, Huron, Benedictine-boys only, Magnificat-girls only, Perkins, Ontario.  
**High School Red division:** Jones Academy-boys only, Elyria Catholic, St. Joe Central Catholic, St., Mary's Central Catholic, Danbury, Put-n-Bay.  
**The HS Red & Gray divisions will run together. The results will be separated for the HS only. The different divisions will be indicated on the bib numbers to help coaches identify each.**
- Middle schools:** Briar, Crestline, Danbury, St. Mary's, Sandusky, Huron. St. Joe, Tiffin, Westside Academy, Put n Bay, Ontario, Bellevue.
- Awards:** HS-Gray division, Red division, & Middle school.
- Course:** Mostly flat 5 km and 2 mile course consisting of grass, dirt paths, crushed stone, and a few asphalt crossings. Suggested spike size of  $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{3}{8}$  inch.

### **Erie Metro Park Rules**

- When parking a car in any of the MetroParks, lock car doors and close the windows.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any of the parks.
- Dogs and cats may accompany their owners in the MetroParks as long as they are on a leash not more than 8 feet long. All animal waste must be placed in a litter receptacle.
- Parking is allowed in designated areas only and is limited. Motor vehicles must be kept off the grass unless directed by MetroParks staff. Regular traffic and posted speed regulations are enforced.
- Recreational use of ATVs, all purpose vehicles, and snowmobiles is not permitted in the parks.
