

2019 Johnstown Harrier Showdown- Saturday, October 5th 2019

Revised Race Schedule Below:

This year's invitational will again be held at the Johnstown Community Sportsman's Club located at 7357 Sportsman's Club Rd., Johnstown, OH 43031. The course is a three loop, grass course over slightly rolling terrain. All parts of the race are visible and accessible to spectators, which makes for an exciting race environment.

High School races will be divided into Hawks and Hounds divisions. The Hawks division is the more competitive division for larger teams (D1 and large D2/3 teams). The Hounds division is for smaller teams of any division. Coaches, please choose your race accordingly on Baumspage. We plan to cap the size of the races at approximately 150 due to course limitations.

Entries must be completed on Baumspage by Wednesday, October 2nd at midnight.

Here is the revised schedule:

8:00 am Elementary Girls Mile race - (\$5 entry fee, Open to all runners 6th grade and younger with 100 ribbons and first and second place team plaques)

8:30 am Elementary Boys Mile race - (\$5 entry fee, Open to all runners 6th grade and younger with 100 ribbons and first and second place team plaques)

9:00 am Middle School Boys (Top 3 teams get trophies, medals to top 40 runners)

9:30 am Middle School Girls (Top 3 teams get trophies, medals to top 40 runners)

10:00 am High School Women's Race (Top 3 teams in each division get trophies, medals to top 40 runners)

10:40 am High School Men's Race (Top 3 teams in each division get trophies, medals to top 40 runners)

***Due to having approximately 86 HS Boys running and 99 HS Girls running we plan to run the Hawks and Hounds together but do the team scores separately. We've purchased the awards; we're going to give them out. The top 3 teams in each division (Hawks/Hounds) will still receive team plaques, but this will give us a more competitive race. High School ended up being a little smaller than anticipated this year.**

New this year we have a slot for a team photo on the team plaques to 1st-3rd place teams. When you go up to get your trophy please be ready for a team photo and we will send a print for the plaque.
