

Wildcat Invitational Covid-19 Guidelines

I: Pre Race

When teams arrive at Kalida Fish & Game:

- There will be a specific area to drop athletes off
- Coaches will also be responsible for picking up team packets
- No tents please, they promote congregating. All camps will be located on the gun range to allow social distancing. Camps are for coaches and athletes only, no spectators.
- Porta Restrooms will be available to athletes. Fish & Game building restrooms will also be available.
- Hand sanitation stations placed throughout the grounds and by all restrooms.
- Warm ups will be permitted on the course with groupings of 10 or less.

II: Race

When teams arrive at the starting line:

- Teams with their coach will not “check-in” It will be the coach’s responsibility to make sure that athletes are at the starting line on time.
- Coaches will be pre-assigned a starting box. Teams are to wait in the staging area beside the starting line with masks on and socially distanced until 5 minutes until the start of the race. At that time, the runners should safely enter their starting boxes.
- The starting line will be broken up into 6 foot boxes with 6-foot dead spacing in between boxes.
- No team huddles or run outs will be permitted prior to the race.
- The official will whistle a long blow as a warning to get ready then the starter will start the ‘race starting sequence’.

III: Post Race:

When teams finish their race:

- Each team must provide a masked coach or an adult team representative near the finish area (but no closer than 30’ from the finish line) to assist a team member that might need help at the finish. Each team is responsible for providing water for their athletes.
- Athletes cannot linger at the finish area. This means not even to support their teammates. All athletes should immediately return to their team camp after the race.
- We will issue individual awards at the end of the race. Team awards can be picked up at the awards table. Results will be posted on Baumspage.

IV: Spectators:

- Please limit the amount of spectators to immediate family members only.
- Spectators should not show up more than 10 min. prior to their child’s race time.
- All spectators must enter through the south bridge and exit through the north bridge to the parking lot.
- Must conduct daily symptom assessment. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
- Six-foot social distancing must be maintained between individual’s/family groups.
- Porta Restrooms will be available to spectators. Fish & Game building restrooms will also be available.
- Hand sanitation stations placed throughout the grounds and by all restrooms.
- No congregating before or after the invitational is permitted.
- Spectators must wear face coverings at all times except for any of the allowable exceptions stated in the Director's Order for Facial Coverings throughout the State of Ohio.

Wildcat Invitational Covid-19 Guidelines

- Spectators must stay out of the team camp area.
- Spectators must stay in designated areas that will be marked for spectators around the course. A map will be provided to all schools prior to race competition.
- Security, compliance officers and race officials will be patrolling the campus ensuring guidelines are being followed. If guidelines are not being followed, you will receive one friendly reminder and if corrective action is not taken you will be removed from campus.
