!!!TIME SCHEDULE-We will attempt to make up lost time by possibly starting some races a few minutes before the designated start time.

Race Day Registration: Coaches may pick up packets as they enter the stadium. The packets will contain the program and the following items:

- 1. Numbers for every athlete, with safety pins to be worn on the front.
- 2. Map of the course-all starts will be evident on the map.
- 3. Starting position
- 4. Copy of this information sheet.
- 5. Instructions to runners
- 6. D-tags that are assigned to each runner (do not flatten D-tags).

Team Scoring-Important! All runners in all races will wear a number on the front of their singlet.

\*\*Awards\*\* There will be many pictures, medals, ribbons and merchandise awards. Given out at the conclusion of the race.

**T-Shirts for sale**: long sleeve, short sleeve and sweatshirts will be available.

Results: We will be using FinishTiming (FinishingTiming.com) - printed results will be posted but not individually distributed.

\*\*Teams will be issued timing chips and each coach will be responsible for returning each chip after competition.

### REGISTRATION:

- 1. When you pick up your packet you may return chips for athletes that are not competing if applicable.
- 2. GlenOak High School is located at 1801 Schneider St NE. We think you will find the course to be challenging and spectator friendly.
- 3. **Coaches Packet** Pick up in the Ticket Booth in the Main Entrance as you enter the Football Stadium. \*\*Teams will be issued timing chips and each coach will be responsible for returning each chip after competition.
- 4. Parking All vehicles should enter from Schneider Rd.; there are two large lots available for parking; there will be a \$3.00 admission fee per car. (NO CARS CAN PARK IN THE FRONT PUBLIC LIBRARY PARKING LOT).
- 5. **Team Camps** We ask that team camps be set up in the field area between the practice football field and the stadium complex, as marked on the map. The camps will be near the concessions and t-shirt sales, which will be located inside the Stadium.
- 6. Entry fee If you still owe entry fee money, you must make payment before receiving your packet.
