Meet Details and Layout

Races will begin on the hour and will not start early. The meet will start at 8:00am with a maximum number of 150 participants on the starting line. Teams have the choice to enter both boys and girls varsity and junior varsity runners. The participants of each race will be marshalled to four large starting boxes, separated by approximately 10-12 feet. Coaches will be given an assigned race time 1 week prior to race day.

Race Results, Scoring and Management

After all races are completed, a final team ranking will be tallied and awards will be mailed out. Meet management will also assign the quad meet teams based on competitiveness.

Entering coaches will place their team in one of the 3 categories---

Red Team Race-- Highest level of competition

White Team Race-- 2nd level of competition

Blue Team Race-- 3rd level of competition

Scoring-- 1. Overall 2. Within the three levels 3. Based on race

Awards-- Individual and team awards for each of the three levels
