**Check-In:** Packets will be available at the finish line at 7:30AM. Please only send one coach to pick up packets. FAB Timing will be timing the meet and results can be found at [FABtiming.com](http://FABtiming.com). **There will be a coaches meeting at the start line at 8:30AM.**

**Please do not miss the coaches meeting.**

**Results:** There will be live results on [FABtiming.com](http://FABtiming.com) and all results will be posted there and on *Baumspage* after the meet. There will be no paper copies passed out to coaches.

## **Awards:**

-Top 10 High Schoolers will receive medals

-Top 10 Middle Schoolers will receive medals

-There will be NO team awards given

-Awards will be available to be picked up by coaches at the end of the meet. There will be no medals handed out in the chute and no medals will be mailed.

**Course:** Course maps are available on *Baumspage*. Paper copies of maps will also be available at the finish line. The course is mostly on grass with some rolling hills. The finish is a final 350m on the track. *Please limit spike size to ¼" for the preservation of*

*our track surface.* The course will close for inspection at 8:45am. Teams will be assigned to a starting box, masks must be worn to the starting line. At the finish, athletes will report to their team area on the infield, which will have water and will be marked with the school name.

**Warm Up Areas:** Each school will be given a designated warm-up/cool down area. These areas are the only places the teams may warm-up and cool down. *There will be no warm ups or cool downs done on the course.* Team camp areas are closed to spectators. Please relay this to your parents so they do not visit team camps after races. Athletes may not report to the start line until 5 minutes before the start of their race. There will be no run outs at the start line.

**Spectators:** Spectators will be limited to 2 per athlete. Our stadium can only hold 533 people at any given time. We will not allow the capacity to be exceeded, so please remind parents to leave the stadium after their athlete has finished. **Spectators must wear masks at all times, while in the stadium. Spectators inside the stadium will only be permitted in the stands, and may NOT stand along the fence. Spectators outside of the stadium on the course must read all signage to ensure they do not interfere with the races. Masks do NOT need to be worn outside of the stadium, but 6 foot social distancing must be maintained.** Schools with spectators not following COVID guidelines will be asked to leave and if they do not comply, will be reported to the OHSAA. Admission to the event is \$5 per person (maximum of \$10 per family) per the KMAC guidelines.
