Course location: New London Local Schools 80 acre complex at 1 Wildcat Drive off of Route 60 on the south edge of New London. This meet will allow you the flexibility as a coach to determine what is best for your athletes on the weekend prior to conference meets. It is a flat course with a wooded area that will allow your athletes to challenge their personal bests prior to the conference meet.

Fees: \$150.00 for HS teams, \$75.00 for MS teams; \$225.00 total if bringing HS and MS teams

Kids Fun Run:

We will be hosting a kids fun run after the last race. Youth under 7th grade are welcome from all schools. Popsicles will be provided at the finish line.

High School Races:

Coaches may choose which race/races they want their athletes to run in. You may enter athletes in both races if you wish, however in order to receive team awards, you must have at least 5 athletes finish in a race. Both races will be scored using normal scoring procedures with both team and individual awards being handed out in each race. Trophies will be handed out to the top 2 teams in each race, and medals will be handed out to the top 15 individuals in each race

Race #1

Our first high school race will be a normal 5k race that can be used as a final tune-up before conference or a race for your second team prior to postseason tournaments.

Race #2

Our second high school race will be a 2 mile race that can be used as a shorter tune- up race before conference, a chance for your athletes to aim for old school records, or a change of pace before the post-season begins.

Middle School Races:

Our middle school races will be 2 miles in distance and will allow coaches to run all of their athletes in the same race. Team scoring will be determined by normal scoring procedures, with the top two teams earning trophies and the top 15 individuals earning medals.

Changes to your roster can be made at the meet headquarters located under by the entrance to the school. All changes must be made at least 30 min before the scheduled start time of that race.

2. Please drop athletes off in front of New London High School when you arrive and then the buses will be directed behind the school to another parking lot.
3. You will pick up race packets at meet headquarters located at the entrance area behind the bell under the overhang.
