### Packets

Please pick up your packets near the start and finish line when you arrive at the meet. As usual, we will be attempting to greet your team bus with your packets as you arrive. In your packet you will receive bibs that are to be placed on the front of the runners’ jerseys. New this year we will be using electronic chip timing. A correlating chip for each runner will also be in your packet, and the bib and chip number should match. Finally, starting boxes have been randomly assigned and a sheet is in the packet.

### Chip Timing

In each packet there will be a bib number and chip for each runner you submitted on baumspage. All runners must return their chip to the chip bucket after finishing their race before exiting the finish chute area. Coaches, if you have runners who do not compete, you are responsible for turning in their chips! A fee of \$25 will be charged to your athletic director for each chip not turned in from your school.

Admission to the event will be \$5.00 per vehicle. Any money made will go directly to the league fund.
