Race Numbers

Each of your runners is assigned a number, which you'll find on your roster. Make sure you use the number in the column marked "Comp#." Coaches should mark each of their own runners with a marker on their RIGHT HAND with a PERMANENT MARKER as shown.

Please be sure to mark your athletes clearly & consistently. It is very important that the finish line personnel can read off the numbers & move the runners smoothly through the chute.
