

REGIONAL CROSS COUNTRY @ TROY SATURDAY OCTOBER 31, 2015

The OHSAA admission price will be \$7.00 for age 6 and older.

To Course: I-75 to exit #74, seven traffic lights into Troy, left on Adams St. or SR55 into the Round About in the center of Troy, go one block north over the bridge.

COURSE: Is south of Troy Memorial Stadium, start next to river, run on levee, and finish is behind the stadium. See Map. Course is always open, will be roughed in the week prior. . SAME COURSE AS 2011 -2014.

PACKET PICK UP: West end of stadium at chute gate. East end of Hobart Arena parking lot. Sign the Coaches Verification Form to receive your packet. Ten wristband per team for coaches and athletes. Individuals + one coach.

CHIP SCORING: One chip per athlete tied on RIGHT FOOT, return chips in chute.
CONTESTANT NUMBERS: Bib numbers must be pinned high on the FRONT and hip numbers placed on the LEFT HIP if used.

SPECTATORS will NOT be permitted on the bridges or the flood plain.

BUS PARKING : North and South of Aquatic Center.

VAN PARKING : East and north of Aquatic Center next to stadium, near camps.

CAMP LOCATION: (SEE MAP.) NO CAMPS INSIDE THE COURSE ON LEVEE.

RESTROOMS FOR ATHLETES ; Under North Stadium near camps.

FACILITIES: Concessions stands and restrooms under south stadium.

RECREATIONAL EQUIPMENT, PETS : will not be permitted at the meet site.

HOBART ARENA : Because of other events your athletes are NOT permitted to enter.

STARTING BOX : posted on Finishtiming.com and baumspage .com

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each race on the stage.

Team - Regional Champions and Runner-Up in each race.

Individuals Awards to each team member and the top 16 finishers in each race.

STATE QUALIFIERS: The top 4 teams,& the top 16 individuals in each race should report to the awards stage 20 minutes after your race. All four teams will be introduced and pick up State Meet paper work.

FIRST AID: Will be available on the course and at the chute. An ambulance will transport to Upper Valley Medical Center located on North CR25A.
