## Hello Coaches and Athletic Directors!

This year Seneca East will be hosting its second annual nighttime meet, and as you are aware, this one is SPECIAL! We are extremely excited to have this opportunity, and have been working extraordinarily hard in an attempt to cover all of the details like $t$-shirts, parking, concession stands, giant flags, fireworks, and a possible flyover! The course is different from the normal Tiger Classic course (if you have run at that meet), and it starts behind the baseball/softball fields, runs onto the track, then adds a loop in the woods, before coming back along the township road and heading onto the track to finish under the stadium lights in front of the grandstands! On the day of the race, the course will be clearly marked and painted as if it's a highway. Course maps are attached to the email, and will also be in each of your packets at the meet. There are three divisions for the meet, Division 1 (Stars), Division 2 (Stripes), and Division 3 (Lights). Division 1 is the only division to have an open race (due to numbers). In Division 1, up to 14 athletes can compete in the varsity race, runners 15 -end must compete in the open race Division 2 and 3 will have unlimited entries. We will be using electronic chip timing! Please ensure you turn in all used and unused chips at the awards table! Any chip not turned in will result in a $\$ 25.00$ fee sent to your school athletic director. We truly hope you enjoy your evening at Seneca East! Any feedback is more than welcome, and will be reviewed for future meets as our ultimate goal is to put on a first-class event for everyone!

## T-shirts \& Concessions

T-shirts will be available near the concession stand area for a cost of $\$ 15.00$. The concession stand at the end of the track will be open, and sandwiches, snacks, and beverages will be for sale.

## Team Drop-off Information \& Bus Parking

Buses will be directed by workers to circle behind the school, come up to the corner near the complex building, and unload athletes. Buses will then proceed to park in at the Attica Fairgrounds ( 15127 E . Twp. Rd. 12, Attica, OH 44807). Pickup will operate the same way as buses will be directed to circle behind the school before picking up athletes at the corner by the complex. The bus route is detailed on a map that is attached to this email.

## Team Camps

Team Camps will be located in the area behind the starting line and beyond the softball field. Due to traffic flow you will have to walk a couple hundred yards to reach team camp area.

## Spectator Parking

There is a $\$ 5.00$ charge per person, or a $\$ 10.00$ maximum per vehicle to attend. There is one entrance into the school campus. All spectators will drive through the entry line, and then proceed to park. Please be extra careful while parking during the evening hours.
