

50th Tiffin Cross Country Carnival September 8, 2018.

Tiffin Columbian Boosters will have a large tent with grilled hamburgers, hot dogs, shredded chicken sandwiches, pizza, chips, fresh fruit, donuts, candy and many other food items to choose from. Coffee and cold drinks will also be available.

T-shirts (short sleeve and long sleeve) and performance wear available for purchase from \$15 to \$25 at the T-Shirt Tent. The shirt selection is on display along one side of the large tent. Purchase shirts in the small tent at the end.

Elementary Races - will be held beginning at 4:00. Registration and the race are now located on Heidelberg soccer fields in the bottom portion of the park. See the elementary tabs for maps and registration information.

*The Tiffin Carnival runs on strict time lines unless there is a delay for the weather or athlete safety issues.

* Although this is a fantastic, safe, and family orientated event, safety is our concern. We encourage the buddy system if you want to walk around the park.

*Please be aware of the race course. It is marked with a white line. Do not park or stand on the course.

* Many families and teams bring grills with them to use throughout the day. Please do not cook near the course so that runners will not have to run through any smoke. Smoking grills will be asked to move.

* All lost items will be held at the tent next to the medical tent. Cell phones are turned in every year. If not locked, we will attempt to call back a few recently received calls to locate the owner before the Carnival is over.

* If you park along the large circle at the top of the park please remember that the street is a one way street. Many cars try to leave going the wrong way.

* Handicapped parking is available. You must have a tag or license plate with handicapped parking authorization in order to park in this lot.

*Hedges Boyer Park is located at 491 Coe St. Tiffin Ohio 44883.

*We encourage spectators to enter the park using the rear entrance from Summit Street and park at the bottom of the park. This will reduce the traffic and parking congestion at the top of the park (traffic is stopped in four places during races.) There is a short walk to reach the start/finish area, but it will be worth the walk. This will aid in easy entry and exiting of the park. If you are planning on using the Coe St. entrance you will experience a wait just to enter the park. Leave early so you will not miss your race!

* Drones are NOT allowed to be flown during this event.

*Cell phone coverage on this day is spotty and sometimes does not work at all during this event due to the large number of people that attend. You cannot rely on using your phone. Make plans to meet your group at a certain time/place before separating in case your phone does not work.

*We look forward to seeing parents and families at this fun event! This is Cross Country! Many of the states' top runners will be competing.
