

Check in Procedures:

- 1) All wrestlers and coaches will enter through door B6. Only coaches and wrestlers will be admitted. NO mat-stats, no video persons, no managers, no extras this year due to the Covid restrictions. Please, help us out with this so it doesn't become an issue at the door.
- 2) All qualifying wrestlers and coaches will be escorted to the field house with the proper credentials. ***Please Note*** Alternates will be escorted to our commons area and will sit masked and sociality distanced until we need them. If an alternate is going to be a replacement, we will come and get that wrestler, credential him, and he will be directed to the field house.
- 3) All coaches and wrestlers will wait in the field house to be called for weigh-ins. Once weigh-ins are complete and the field is finalized, all alternates will be asked to leave the facility.
- 4) Check in times are from 8:30 – 9:00 & 3:00-3:30. We will have 4 check in tables. Please check in at your respective sectional site table.
- 5) Weigh-in times start at 9:00 & 3:30. We will call those by weight class.
- 6) Coaches meetings will start @ 9:45 & 4:15.
- 7) Wrestling will start @ 10:00 and 4:30.

Bullpen Procedures:

- 1) All wrestlers and coaches must stay in the warm up. There is to be NO ONE going to the gymnasium unless on deck or actively wrestling. Live feeds from each match will be streamed in the warmup area.
- 2) Wrestlers can enter the bullpen tunnel when they are in the hole and then will be escorted to their respective mat. This is to limit the number of persons in the gymnasium.
- 3) After the completion of the match, the winning wrestler will drop off their bout sheet at the head table and exit the designated tunnel back to the warm up area. The losing wrestler will exit the designate tunnel back to the warm up area.
- 4) At the completion of a session, all coaches and wrestlers will have to exit immediately out door B9. We will clean and sanitize the area for the next session.

Number of coaches allowed **PER SESSION:**

Coaches will be admitted into the facility in accordance with the outline below on a per session basis:

- 1 qualifier - 2 coaches
- 2 - 4 qualifiers - 3 coaches
- 5 - 7 qualifiers - 4 coaches

Example: If you have 5 qualifiers, 2 in session #1 and 3 in session #2, you get 3 coaches in session #1 and 3 coaches in session #2. You do NOT get 4 coaches in each session. The coaches can be the same or different but will be credentialed at each session. This is the same for wrestlers. 2 wrestlers in session #1, will not be able to stay with the 3 wrestlers in session #2, and vice versa.
