 **Team Entrance & Check-In**

- Enter via **Activity Entrance** (across from track)
- Report to **Auditorium**
- Head coach completes paperwork & submits pass list
- Teams then report to **Main Gym**

Head Coach Must Submit:

- EDAB Pass List (wrestlers + alternates)
- Up to 6 team personnel
- Extra personnel sheet
- Skin authorizations

Weigh-Ins – Friday

11:00 AM

- Wrestlers remain in main gym until called
- Must wear singlet
- Skin authorizations required

- Begin at 106 lbs → conclude at 285 lbs
- 2 attempts on first scale, 1 on alternate

Weigh-out: TBA - Wrestlers may weigh out only after they are done wrestling for the day.

Other Personnel & Wristband Information

Each team may list up to three (3) additional individuals who will accompany the team.

This may include:

- Assistant Coaches
- Managers
- Athletic Trainers
- Team Physicians
- Bus Drivers
- Statisticians

Free Admission

- These individuals will receive **FREE admission** to the tournament.
- This is **in addition to** the three (3) Floor/Hospitality Coach wristbands each team receives

Additional Wristbands Based on Number of Wrestlers

Teams will also receive extra FREE admission wristbands based on the number of wrestlers entered:

- **1–2 Wrestlers** → 0 extra bands
- **3–4 Wrestlers** → 1 extra band
- **5–6 Wrestlers** → 2 extra bands
- **7 or more Wrestlers** → 3 extra bands

⚠ Extra bands provide **free entry only** and do **NOT** include hospitality access

Example

If Coshocton qualifies **3 wrestlers**:

- 3 Floor/Hospitality wristbands (free entry + floor access + hospitality)
- 3 Additional Personnel (free entry)
- 1 Extra Admission wristband (free entry only, no hospitality)

With 55+ participating schools, this results in over **165+ individuals** utilizing tournament access areas and hospitality spaces.
