

# Trackwrestling Scoring Scenarios

To use a 16-Man Bracket for OHSAA Sectionals and Pre-Regionals

## Goals:

1. To be consistent and use a 16-line bracket for all OHSAA Sectional and Pre-Regional Tournaments.
2. To score all sectional and pre-regional tournaments by NFHS rule and not award bye points for rounds with NO matches,
3. To adjust for an error in the Trackwrestling scoring algorithm rounds with No matches (All Byes) must be designated as Non-Scoring.

## Samples and Details:

1. Click the samples below for examples of brackets with scoring errors.

2. **On the Championship Side of a 16-wrestler bracket:**
  - Mark all 1<sup>st</sup> Round Matches as **Non-Scoring** if there are only 8 wrestlers!
  - If there are only 4 wrestlers, mark the first two rounds as **Non-Scoring**.
  - If there are with only 2 wrestlers, they would need to mark the first three rounds as **Non-Scoring**.
3. **On the Consolation side of a 16-wrestler bracket:**
  - For weights with 9 to 16, pay attention to the numbers.
    - 13 or more wrestlers will be ok.
    - For 9 to 12 they would need to mark all 1st Consolation Round Matches as **Non-Scoring**.
  - For weights with 5 to 8, pay attention to the numbers.
    - The 1st Consolation Round Matches will show all Byes.
    - For 7 or 8 wrestlers the 2nd Consolations will be ok.
    - For 5 or 6 mark all 3rd Consolation Matches as **Non-Scoring**.
  - For weights with 3 and 4, pay attention to the numbers.
    - **(I need help with this one.)**
    - The 1st and 2nd Consolation Round Matches will show all Byes. And probably the 3rd Consolation too.
    - Set the Consolation Semifinal Matches to **Non-Scoring**.
