IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Please arrive at Steubenville High School no later than 7:00 AM.
2. **You should plan on dropping off and entering the school on either Logan Street (north side of school) or Dock Street (south side of school).**
3. Weigh-ins will begin at 7:30 in the high school gym (you will be given directions upon arrival). You may check your weight from 6:45 until 7:15.
4. Coaches seeding meeting will take place in the Keenan Conference Room 15 minutes after weigh-ins begin (approximately 7:45 AM).
5. Doors to the gym will open at 8:30 for all spectators.
6. **Wrestling will begin at 9:00 with Session 1.** Weight classes 106 thru 145 will wrestle to conclusion.
7. At the conclusion of Session 1, the gym will be cleared and sanitized.
8. Weigh-ins for Session 2 will begin at 1:15 in the Wells Academy gym (you will be given directions upon arrival). You may check weight from 12:30 until 1:00.
9. Coaches seeding meeting for weight classes 152 thru 285 will begin at 1:30
10. We are anticipating Session 2 starting around 2:30 with weight classes 152 thru 285
11. Tickets for each session are \$10.00 and can only be purchased online.
12. All entries and seeding criteria must be submitted via baumspage.com before 7:00 PM on Thursday, February 25, 2021. Schools will be subject to a \$50 fine for wrestlers entered after the deadline.

Coaches who are inappropriately dressed will not be allowed on the competition floor. Moral behavior and ethical conduct are part of winning and losing. Good sportsmanship, appearance, honor, and concern for the well-being of the competitors must be every coach's priority. The Rules have been established in the spirit of this statement.
