Rules of Competition

Rules Committee: Kelly Morrow, PGA Professional, TBA, TBA

Play is governed by the current USGA Rules of Golf stroke play will prevail.

Format: Team scores will be determined by the scores from the four players with the fewest strokes for the match.

**ALL OHSAA RULES AND GUIDELINES ARE IN EFFECT.

TEE MARKERS- All competitors will play from the Gold Tee Markers.

20.1.c. Doubt as to Procedure, Playing Two Balls-

Playing Two Balls. *If you are uncertain about the right procedure while playing a hole, you may complete the hole with two balls without penalty:*

- *You must decide to play two balls after the uncertain situation arises and before making a [stroke](#).*
- *You should choose which ball will count if the Rules allow the procedure used for that ball, by announcing that choice to your [marker](#) or to another player before making a [stroke](#).*
- *If you do not choose in time, the ball played first is treated as the ball chosen by default.*
- *You must report the facts of the situation to the [Committee](#) before returning your [scorecard](#), even if you score the same with both balls. You are **disqualified** if you fail to do so.*

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by White stakes and lines, and boundary fences.

PENALTY AREAS- DEFINED BY RED AND YELLOW STAKES AND LINES.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR : Defined by white lines.

***Power Lines: A ball striking a power line must be replayed.**

Electronic Measuring Devices: In accordance with USGA Rules AND OHSAA Rules and Guidelines.

Electronic Communication Devices

The use of any electronic communication devices shall be prohibited on the course during any competition by all players and coaches except in cases of emergency. All phones including those used by spectators shall remain on silent.

Penalty shall be: Player- 1st offense- two strokes

2nd offense- disqualification

Coach-

1st offense- lose coaching privilege

2nd offense- disqualification

Course Set-Up

Hole

1. Out of bounds left. Penalty Area fronting the fairway.
2. Out of bounds left.
3. Out of bounds left. Red Penalty Area to the right of the fairway. Yellow Penalty Area fronting green. *There are two different drop areas available to a ball that is lost in the Penalty Area to the right of the fairway. The player must select the drop area that is no closer to the hole.*
4. Out of bounds left.
5. Penalty Area left of the green. *There will be a drop area that is short of the green available for any player hitting their ball in the Penalty Area.*
6. Out of bounds left.
7. Out of bounds left defined by white lines and boundary fence. *There will be a drop area for any player hitting their ball in the Penalty Area..*
8. Out of bounds left. Penalty Area in front of the teeing ground.
9. Out of bounds left. Penalty Area in front of the teeing ground.
10. Penalty Area in front of the green. Out of bounds to the right. *There will be a drop area for any player hitting their ball in the Penalty Area that fronts the green.*
11. Penalty Area running through the hole.

13. No out of bounds. Penalty Area short and left of the green.

16. No out of bounds or Penalty Area. Note: A ball that goes left can easily be lost. Player should consider hitting a provisional ball.
17. Penalty Area to the right of the cart path. *A drop area will be available for any player hitting a ball in the Penalty Area.*
18. Penalty Area in front of the teeing area. Out of bounds behind the green.
