

COVID-19 Coach & Player Protocols

1. Prior to departing for the golf course, it is each coach's responsibility to conduct COVID-19 symptom checks for his/her team. Any golfer and/or coach exhibiting symptoms should be sent home immediately and should not be transported to the golf course. Please complete the attached COVID-19 monitoring form and turn it in at to the tournament official. We will use this form as your line-up as well. This form may be requested by the county health department should contact tracing need to take place.
2. Facial coverings are required when on your transportation vehicle and should be worn throughout the day except when the players are on the practice range or competing. Coaches should wear facial coverings throughout the day when they are unable to maintain a distance of 6 feet.
3. In addition to bringing snacks and facial coverings, players are also encouraged to bring their own personal hand sanitizer.
4. Remind your players to practice "social distancing" as much as possible while they are at and on the golf course. Do not gather on the tee boxes or near the holes. We need to avoid large congregations of players and coaches.
5. Players and coaches should refrain from entering the clubhouse as much as possible. Restrooms will be available in the clubhouse and on the golf course. If clubhouse entry is necessary, facial coverings are required at all times.
6. Upon arrival, coaches and players should not leave their team transportation vehicle until their range time starts.
7. We will **NOT** have a coaches meeting or large group gathering to go over the rules. Scorecards will be given at the tee and the rules will be up prior to the event on Baum's Page. Please go over these rules prior to the event. The COVID symptom checklist will be turned in and used as your line up.
8. Each player will have an assigned time for the range and practice green (range fee included in entry fee). Please make sure they know when they are allowed on these areas. These times are posted on the tee time sheet. Players are expected to enter and leave these areas at said times. These rules will be strictly enforced. We will not allow the whole team at the range or on the putting green at once. **The range is limited to shots that carry no more than 200 yards in the air.**
9. Players should arrive to their first tee 10 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time to get their scorecard and go over any additional rules.
10. Each player should keep score for every player in their group using the scorecards provided at the tee. At the completion of the round, each group should verbally verify scores hole-by-hole. This verification should take place away from others. Scorecards **DO NOT** need to be signed, attested or added up. We will use all four scorecards to determine each players score. Players who will not be in a playoff should return to their school transportation and wait there for others. If there is no transportation nearby, players will be sent to safe areas around the clubhouse.
11. Teams should depart the golf course as soon as the scorecards are turned in with the exception of anyone who may be in a playoff. There will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony. Results of the event will be available on Baum's Page and Pine Hills website.
12. During any and all weather delays, players must wait them out in their transportation vehicle or in an area designated by the golf course. The clubhouse area will not be available.
