## **Rules Sheet for Division I Districts**

- 1. You are keeping score for ONE other player in your group. Paper scorecards are the **OFFICIAL** form used for scoring, not the electronic version. Please write scores in a legible manner.
- 2. At least one player in each group will keep unofficial live scoring on their cell phone, but it is preferred and expected that everyone shall keep their <u>own</u> score electronically. Please mark scores down before teeing off on the next hole so you do not fall behind in scoring. We will use the electronic scorecard to post unofficial 9-hole scores.
- 3. After the completion of play, we ask the group to go over everyone's scores hole by hole. **The scorecard should be signed by both the player and the marker**. All questions regarding rules and or scoring should be acknowledged before turning in your card. If there is a scoring discrepancy after cards are turned in, the golf committee may use the electronic scorecard as a secondary confirmation. Please make sure electronic scores are correct as well. Do not leave the scoring area until your score is locked in.
- 4. Rules for the day:
  - A. Stroke Play from the Blue Tees. USGA and OHSAA Rules apply plus these local rules.
  - B. Mark, Lift, Clean and Place in your own fairway 1 club length no closer to the hole.
  - C. Hole 10 will be played from the designated green tee area as a par 4 for this event.
  - D. Embedded Ball Rule is in effect through the green.
  - E. Mulched areas, including pine straw and flower beds, may be played as ground under repair.
  - F. Tall un-mowed areas will be treated as a red staked penalty area.
  - G. Ground torn up by animals or construction vehicles should be played as ground under repair. This includes areas around new cart paths.
  - H. The cement/black top around the clubhouse, cart facility and maintenance building is O.B. Cart path around #10 tee and below putting green is in play.
  - I. Drop area on hole #4 for balls hit into the penalty area on the right hill.
  - J. Free drop from green wooden fence behind #7 green if it interferes with your stance or swing only, not line of sight. Drop area located short of the right bunker.
  - K. The path between the lakes on #18 is in the penalty area. You may **NOT** drop in this area.
  - L. When in doubt, play 2 balls, but you must declare which ball you want to count **BEFORE** playing the second ball. You may also use the scoring app to summons a Rules Official.
- 8. We have spotters on most holes. They will not find every ball hit so help them out. Please point in the direction of your drive so they have a better chance of finding it.
- 9. **Do not ask a spotter for rules help**. Play 2 balls whenever there is a problem, but declare which ball you want to count before playing them. **You may also use the scoring app to summons a Rules Official**.
