Local Rules and Conditions of the Competition

Red Hawk Run Golf Course - District Tournaments

UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, THE PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE OR CONDITION IS TWO STROKES.

1. USGA rules govern play except where superseded by Local Rules.
2. **Format** - Stroke play a stipulated round of 18 holes; from Boys Gold Tees,
3. **The note to Rule 6-3** is in effect: The player must start at the time established by the Committee. This means if your tee time is 10:00am you must be on the tee at 10:00am **NOT 10:00:01**.
4. **Out of Bounds** – All public roadways and white stakes indicate out of bounds
5. **Pace of Play** - for each round will be 4:34 hours. Refer to separate Pace of Play Policy.
6. **Embedded ball** rule is in effect through the green.
7. **Distance-Measuring Devices** – are allowed.
8. **Ground under repair** - marked with white lines. Severely damaged areas of the course caused by non-burrowing animals (geese/skunks) are played as ground under repair.
9. **Flower Beds** mulched and newly seeded areas mandatory relief.
10. **Obstructions**: Cart paths (nearest point), maintenance roads, and extended cart paths.
11. **Drop Zones**:
#3 In front of Red tee markers.
#14 In front of Red tee markers.
12. **Rule 3-3: If you are in doubt** as to procedure or a rules situation, Invoke rule 3-3. Play out your original ball and a second ball taking your relief. Must declare which ball you wish to score with (if rules permit) to your marker before any action is taken. OR Ask a coach to call an official. Record both scores and before signing your card discuss with the rules committee or at the scoring area, your situation.
13. **Spectators** are not allowed any conversation with players, and **MUST** stay on cart paths or rough.
14. **Coaching**: The school **designated head coach ONLY may** speak with his/her players, without any delay of play, between Tee to Green, but not on the Green or in any bunker **providing there is no delay in play**.
15. **Caddies** are not permitted during the tournament. EXCEPTION: A medically authorized waiver is required for the use of a vehicle. A copy of the doctor's statement must be filed with the OHSAA and the OHSAA authorization shown to the referee.
16. **Conduct**. A two-stroke penalty shall be assessed for unsporting conduct. Unsporting conduct shall include but not be limited to club throwing, willful acts which damage property or equipment on the course, use of abusive language, profanity, obscenities, and other unsporting conduct as determined by the Golf Rules Committee. Penalties imposed may result in disqualification.
17. **Scoring area** is defined as: In front of the golf shop. Player and marker should sign reviewing their Hole-by-Hole Score. Both the player and marker **MUST** be present when their scorecard turned into Scorer. **Be sure to tell the scorer if you have any issues that must be brought to the attention of the committee!** Once you leave the scoring area all scores are final.
18. The team score shall be determined by totaling the scores of the 4 players with the fewest strokes for the match. The team with the fewest number of strokes is the winner.
19. **Ties: (see below)**

Team

- a. Ties in team scoring for awards or at qualifying positions that affect the number of qualifiers shall be resolved by comparing the scores of the 5th team member and the team with the lowest 5th score shall be declared the winner. If one team does not have a 5th score, the team with the 5th score shall be declared the winner.
- b. If teams remain tied after comparing the 5th scores, a playoff to determine the winner shall be held using the four players whose scores resulted in the team tie.

Individual (Medalist and Qualifiers)

- c. Individual ties for qualifying positions, that affect the number of qualifiers, shall be resolved by playing an additional hole or holes until the tie is broken by the tied individuals

Rules Committee: The Rules Committee will consist of the USGA Rules Official, the Tournament Director, Assistant Tournament Director, All Rulings of the Rules Committee will be Final.

Water Hazard – YELLOW Stake options

1. Play the ball as it lies without penalty ([Rule 13-1](#)).
2. Play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see [Rule 20-5](#))
3. Drop a ball behind the water hazard, keeping the point at which, the original ball last crossed the margin of the water hazard directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the water hazard the ball may be dropped.

Lateral Water Hazard – RED Stake Options

1. Play the ball as it lies without penalty ([Rule 13-1](#)).
2. Proceed under the stroke and distance provision of Rule [27-1](#) by playing a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule [20-5](#)).
3. Drop a ball behind the [water hazard](#), keeping the point at which the original ball last crossed the margin of the [water hazard](#) directly between the [hole](#) and the spot on which the ball is dropped, with no limit to how far behind the [water hazard](#) the ball may be dropped.
4. Additional options available **only** if the ball last crossed the margin of a [lateral water hazard](#), drop a ball outside the [water hazard](#) within two club-lengths of and not nearer the [hole](#) than (i) the point where the original ball last crossed the margin of the [water hazard](#) or (ii) a point on the opposite margin of the [water hazard](#) equidistant from the [hole](#).

When proceeding under this Rule, the player may lift and clean his ball or [substitute](#) a ball.
