Players should arrive at their starting tee 10 minutes prior to their tee time.

All play will be from the Gold Tee Markers.

USGA and OHSAA rules will be in effect. The one ball rule is not in effect.

Each player will keep the official score for one competitor in their group. The score shall be verbalized by the player so all in the group, including the scorer for that player, can hear. If there is a discrepancy between the score marked and the score announced, the scorer shall ask the player to review her strokes in the presence of the other players. Golfers shall settle all questions on number of strokes before starting the next hole. The score must be verified before the first tee shot is made.

All players in the pairing must keep the score for each hole on the OHSAA app as well. Any player in the group can add those scores. The paper card is the official card.

Pace of play is 45 seconds per shot. Players must stay up with the group ahead and use no more than 15 minutes per hole. Groups falling behind will be encouraged to regain position and then given a verbal warning. Players will be penalized for not regaining position on the course.

Players may have coach call for a rules official if one is needed.

Natural grass areas will be treated as a red penalty areas. The edge of the tall grass will serve as the boundary for the penalty area in natural grass areas. All other penalty areas are marked with a red line.
