

# 2020 OHSAA Girls District Local Rules Sheet

1. **USGA and OHSAA** rules govern play along with all local rules stated below.
2. **Format** - Stroke play from the Slate Tees.
3. **Out of Bounds** is marked with white stakes and paint on holes 2, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 15 and 16.
4. **Bridges/Walkway** on holes 5 and 13 are both in the penalty area. You may not gain relief from or drop in these areas.
5. **Embedded ball** rule is in effect.
6. **Distance Measuring devices** are permitted. Cell phones and Apple Watches are not permitted to be used for measuring distance. 1st violation – 2 stroke penalty, 2nd violation – disqualification.
7. **High grass areas** played as Penalty Area.
8. **Abnormal Ground Conditions** – Drain lines, areas dug up by animals and tire tracks are considered ground under repair. Free drop at nearest point no nearer the hole.
9. **Mulched/Pine Straw** areas to be played as ground under repair. Free drop at nearest point no nearer the hole.
10. **Drop Area NOT** available on hole 7.
11. **Rules Procedure** – If you are in doubt to a rules situation or procedure, you may play 2 balls. You must declare which ball you prefer to score with in case both situations are allowed.
12. **Rules Committee** – Rob Eckenrode, Tournament Director – Greg Andregio, PGA Head Golf Professional – Bryan Harvey, Kent Roosevelt Golf Coach.
13. **Conduct** – Unsportsmanlike conduct or profanity will not be tolerated! 1st violation – warning 2nd violation – disqualification.
14. **Spectators** – are allowed to walk the course on the paths or in the rough only and may **NOT have interaction with players during their round**. Searching for balls is permitted.
15. **Pace of play** – Pace of play for the day is 2 hours 15 minutes for each nine. Remaining groups should maintain a pace within ONE shot of the group in front of you.
16. **Scoring** – You are responsible for the hole by hole scoring of whoever scorecard you have. We will take unofficial 9 hole scores at the turn. **Immediately upon completion of play, all players must proceed to the scoring area**. Please make sure hole by hole scores are legible and correct, you do not need to add up scores. All issues should be brought up to the rules committee at this time before both signatures are on the card. Once the card is signed, turned in and you leave the scoring area, all scores are final.
17. **Playoffs** – All playoffs will start on hole 1 then hole 5 and repeated until all ties are broken.
