

**OHSAA GIRLS DIVISION I DISTRICT GOLF TOURNAMENT –
BROOKLEDGE GOLF CLUB – THURSDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2022**

Rules of Play- All USGA Rules apply. Plus the following local rules:

- You are keeping score for **ONE** other player in your group. Please write scores in a legible manner.
- One player in each group will keep the unofficial live scoring on their cell phone while everyone will keep paper scorecards. Please mark scores down before teeing off on the next hole so that you do not fall behind in scoring.
- After the completion of play, the group needs to go over everyone's score hole by hole. The scorecard should be signed by both the player and the marker. **The scorecard is the official score.**
- Summer Golf – Play the ball as it lies
- There are no “out of bounds” stakes. Fences are used to designate out of bounds and are at the perimeter of the course property.
- All tree lined areas like to the right of #5 and #7 are considered to be “general areas”
- All tall grasses are considered “red penalty areas”. These areas are pretty obvious. They do NOT include edges of tree lined areas that have small trees and bushes.
- Cart paths – you are allowed free relief from cart paths along with the sides and extensions of cart paths that may unfairly affect your play.
- All bodies of water are considered to be red penalty areas. They are not marked with red stakes or red lines. The edges of those penalty areas are defined by where the ground slopes down to form the depression that can hold the water.
- Hole #4 - The area to the right and behind of the green as GUR. They removed about 35 large trees this week, so there are stumps, branches, sawdust and some tire tracks in that area. There will be a drop area behind the green for any ball in that area.

- Hole #5 – In the general area to the right of Hole #5, there is an accumulation of rain water (small pond) that should be treated as “temporary water”.
- Hole #9 – The mulched plant islands behind the green are considered free relief areas. Take the nearest point of relief no closer to the hole.
- Hole #10 – There is no out of bounds to the left of #10. That is all within the course property and is treated as the “general area”.
- Hole #12 – There is a drop area to the right of the green.
- Hole #13 – There is a drop area to the right of the reeds.
- Hole #14 – There is a drop area to the right of the creek in front of the green.
- As always, if you have a question, play two balls on the hole and the issue will be sorted out after the round.
- Play off procedures:
 - Golfers begin on Hole #1

Reminder- All state of Ohio coaching rules are in effect.

- **Only the head coach (1) may speak with their players.**
- **Please remind spectators to keep their distance and not talk to the players.**

All OHSAA rules and guidelines are in effect
