Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and its Decisions, the OHSAA Rules of Play and Pace of Play guidelines, and the Rules Addendum which applies to this golf course.

Tee Markers: Competitors will play from the GREEN tee markers.

Out of Bounds: All out of bounds are defined by white stakes and/or white lines or white fence. Parking lot is out of bounds!

Lateral Hazards: Lateral hazards are marked by red stakes and/or red lines.

Staked Trees: Free relief only if stake or wire interferes with swing or stance.

Immovable Obstructions: All artificial surfaced roads and paths and worn adjacent areas. Rail fences are immovable obstructions and rails may not be removed.

Embedded Ball Rule: Is in effect through the green. Local rule as prescribed in Appendix I shall be in effect.

Flowerbeds: Are to be considered ground under repair from which play is prohibited. You must take relief under Rule 25-1. No relief is granted from only mulched areas.

Accidental Movement of a Ball on a Putting Green: When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment.

The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced."

Time of Starting: Penalty statement under Rule 6-3a shall be in effect.

Pace of Play: See OHSAA Pace of Play Guidelines.

Weather Alarm: In the event of a dangerous situation/bad weather the alarm will be sounded identified by 1 continuous horn. Players must mark the position of their ball and return to the Hills Course golf shop/cart barn area immediately. No continuation of play is permitted after the horn sounds. Review OHSAA Suspension of Play Policy with your coach. OHSAA suspension of play policy dictates all play in the District Tournament will resume from the point of interruption.

Player Conduct: The first tee of the first hole you play serves as your final warning for conduct, tobacco, drugs, and alcohol.
